¹Then *Adonai* said to Abram, "Get going out from your land, and from your relatives, and from your father's house, to the land that I will show you.² My heart's desire is to make you into a great nation, to bless you, to make your name great so that you may be a blessing. ³ My desire is to bless those who bless you, but whoever curses you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth will be blessed. ⁴ So Abram went, just as *Adonai* had spoken to him. Also Lot went with him. (Now Abram was 75 years old when he departed from Haran.)
