



SUPPLY LIST - GRADE SIX

Please have the following items for language arts

- ♣ 1-three ring "hard cover" binder (1") with 5 dividers
- ♣ 1-composition notebook (to be left in the language arts classroom)

Please have the following items for math

- ♣ 1-one-subject spiral notebook
- ♣ 2-pink erasers
- ♣ 20-pencils (10 in a bag labeled with your name, to be given to math teacher)
- ♣ 1-two-pocket folder
- ♣ 1-book cover (can be handmade)
- ♣ White-out correction tape (NOT liquid "White-out")
- ♣ 1 package of graph paper

- ♣ Year-long supply of pencils (if you use mechanical pencils, you must supply your own lead)

- ♣ 1-personal pencil sharpener
- ♣ 1-pair of scissors (must fit in pencil pouch)
- ♣ 3-red correcting pens (one will be collected in math class)
- ♣ 1-20 x 30 poster board (to be brought to art on first day of class)
- ♣ 1-set of colored pencils
- ♣ working headphones
