CEMETERY WEEKLY FEEDING

The families living inside the Chinese Cemetery in Cebu City, have always been closest to Sharon’s heart. We surveyed families that are not in the government food distribution quota, and we have given 15-20lbs of individual rice bags to 200 families. Even though our weekly preparation of food to giveaway to squatters on rotation basis, the Chinese Cemetery feeding has been a weekly event. We have married more than a hundred cemetery residents, converted and baptized them. This November 27, 2021 at our Wedding Crusade there are still more new converts to be baptized and marry.

We met him when he was 17 years old and Manny led him to Christ. Last week, the staff was given an exercise on 'Gratitude'. In their journal, they had to write a true testimony starting A to Z of a spiritual experience. This is what Boyet wrote:

A- Arrows School, I learn about God and the Bible. It changed my life. I learned the purpose in life. I was taught to be a leader and an evangelist.

B- Bible is the source of my strength and correction. I am blessed because there is a book that answers all my questions in life. A book that rebuke and corrects me when I make a mistake. The book that reminds me how blessed I am because God loves me even I am a sinner.

C- Changes in my life. No more fighting, no more hatred. No more with killers and bad company. My heart and life was changed by God

D- Destruction. A lot of destruction in my life. God delivered me from that situation.

G- GCE, I've learned how to drive a motorbike, car, how to cook, speak English. GCE helped me in my spiritual and physical needs. My parents and grandparents are all guerrillas and were all killed in military crossfires. I am an orphan. In GCE I found a beautiful and wonderful family in Christ.

J- Jesus. He is the greatest blessing to me. He gave me hope when I had no one. He is my source of peace, joy and strength. Without Him I am nothing.

I- Ian Ma a very kind teacher from England. He taught us to write our own Bible Study materials. I lead Bible Studies every week with confidence.
