### **How can we be sure that Jesus is the Promised Savior?**

\_\_\_\_\_ of King David, 13:22-23  
Isaiah 9:7

Declared \_\_\_\_\_ by John the Baptist, 13:24-25  
John 1:15

Delivered \_\_\_\_\_ to the world, 13:26-31

- condemned by men as prophets predicted (John 1:11–13)
- crucified and buried as the Scriptures said of him (Zechariah 12:10 and Isaiah 53:9)
- but God \_\_\_\_\_ him from the dead
- seen alive by many witnesses (1 Corinthians 15:5-8)

Acts 13:32-39

Fulfilled prophecies of God given in OT, 13:32-37

- He is God’s \_\_\_\_\_ (13:33), Psalm 2:7, “You are my Son, today I have begotten you.” Begotten means “one and only of his kind” and does not imply created since Jesus is eternal with no beginning or ending.
- He is king forever (13:34), Isaiah 55:3, “I will give you the holy and sure blessings of David.”
- He was raised and will never see corruption (13:35-36), Psalm 16:10, “You will not let your Holy One see corruption.”

Justifies everyone who believes in Him, 13:39  
Romans 3:28; Galatians 2:16, 3:11

Acts 13:40-49

Though many refuse to believe in him, 13:40-45
