Jesus is both Davidic king and God’s Son

1:6, 7	He is God’s Son (Deut. 32:43; Ps 104:4)
1:8, 9	He is Davidic King (Ps 45:6, 7)
1:10–12	He is God’s Son (Ps 102:25–27)
1:13	He is Davidic King (Ps 110:1)
