“in bringing many sons to glory, should make the founder of their salvation perfect through suffering.”

Jesus is the founder (author, originator, leader) Acts 3:15, 5:31

1 Peter 2:21 “For to this you have been called, because Christ also suffered for you,
leaving you an example, so that you might follow in his steps.”

Jesus _____ us, 2:11-13

“For he who sanctifies and those who are sanctified all have one source.” (11a)

Hebrews 10:10, “And by that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ
once for all.”

“That is why he is not ashamed to call them brothers” (11b)

2:12 quoted from Psalm 22:22

2:13 Isaiah 8:17, 18

Jesus never called his disciples brothers until after His resurrection (Matthew 28:10; John 20:17)

Jesus _____ our humanity, 2:14-15

“Since therefore the children **share** in flesh and blood, he himself likewise **partook** of the same things” (14a)

“share” – Gk *koinōnia* “fellowship, communion”

“_____” – Gk *metechō* “taking hold of something that is not naturally one’s own kind”

“that through death he might destroy the one who has the power of death, that is, the devil” (14b)

“and deliver all those who through fear of death were subject to lifelong slavery.” (15)

Jesus _____ with us, 2:16-18

- he was made like us – he came in the flesh (17a)
- he is a merciful and faithful high priest – he is the mediator before us and God (17b)
- he took the _____ of God for us (made propitiation, 17c)
- he suffered and was tempted so he can help us in our temptation (18)
