Mark 9:31 "The Son of Man will be delivered into the hands of men"
Mark 14:17, "one of you will betray me, on who is eating with me."
Jesus endured BETRAYAL
They Jesus, 14:53-65
of many things but testimony didn't match up (14:56)
of planning to destroy the Temple (14:58)
Jesus endured FALSE ACCUSATIONS
High priest asked, "Are you the Christ, the Son of the Blessed?" (14:61)
Jesus answered, "I am, and you will see the Son of Man seated
at the right hand of Power, and coming with the clouds of heaven." (14:62)
They began to spit on him and to strike him
Jesus endured HUMILIATION
Jesus is Lord – "I am" (14:62)
Date: 14:00 70
Peter Jesus, 14:66-72  1st denial - "You were with the Nazarene, Jesus" (14:67)
"I neither know nor understand what you mean." (14:68)
2 <sup>nd</sup> denial - "This man is one of them" (14:69)
But again he denied it. (14:70)
3 <sup>rd</sup> denial - "Certainly you are one of them, for you are a Galilean." (14:70)
But he began to invoke a curse on himself and to swear,
"I do not know this man of whom you speak." (14:71)
Jesus endured DENIAL
They Jesus, 15:1-15
Pilate asked Jesus, "Are you the King of the Jesus?"(15:2)
Jesus answered, "You have said so."
Jesus is KING! (15:2)
Jesus endured INJUSTICE
They Jesus, 15:16-20
purple cloak, thorn of thorns, striking his head with reed, spitting on him, kneeling down before him
Jesus endured Mockery
Jour Grant Tookery
They Jesus, 15:21-32
Jesus endured Crucifixion

Jesus is the Messiah (Hebrew) and Christ (Greek) – "anointed one" Jesus is the Savior
