“the magnificence, worth, loveliness, and grandeur of his many perfections” (Christopher Morgan, TGC)

*kabod* – Hebrew term  
\_\_\_\_\_ – Greek term

through Jesus Christ now and forever

Philippians 4:20, “To our God and Father be glory forever and ever. Amen.”

Romans 11:36, “For from him and through him and to him are all things. To him be glory forever. Amen.”
