## The Missing Piece



“Jesus Is The Missing Piece!”



“The angel said,...‘You are looking for Jesus...He isn’t here. He has been raised from the dead.’” – Matthew 28:5,6

### Say:

There are so many things in this world that compete for the attention of children - fame, fortune, money, popularity, power, and more. It is very tempting to center our lives around these things and build our lives on these things that will not last.

### Ask/Discuss:

- How did Jesus die?
- How many days was Jesus in the tomb?
- Did the disciples expect Jesus to die on the cross?
- Who rolled away the stone from Jesus’ tomb?

### Say:

The Apostle Paul teaches us that Jesus Christ is the only foundation we must build our lives upon. If we choose to build on anything else or if we remove Jesus as the centerpiece of our lives, our lives will crumble and fall.

Jesus is THE most important piece of the puzzle of our lives. Best of all, Jesus is a LIVING Savior who rose from the dead on Easter! His power in us will make our lives everything they were meant to be!

### Ask/Discuss:

- What are some pieces that we try to fit in Jesus’ place?
- What can we do to make sure Jesus is the most important piece in our lives?

### Pray:

Ask your children to examine their lives. If they have been trying to fill the emptiness with anything other than Jesus, pray that they would place Jesus at the center of their lives and daily decisions and that they will follow Him for the rest of their lives.
