Do you know what G.R.O.W. means? It stands for Grateful, Ready, Open, and Willing!

Grateful means saying “thank You” to God every day.

Ready means being prepared to do what God asks.

Open means letting God teach and change your heart.

Willing means saying “yes” when God calls you to help or serve!

Over the next 21 days, you'll read short Bible verses, think about how they apply to your life, talk to God in prayer, and even have questions to help you grow deeper. Each day is a new chance to let your faith bloom like a plant that's watered by God's love.

So grab your Bible, open your heart, and let's G.R.O.W. together!

DAY 01

Psalm 107:1, NIV

"Give thanks to the Lord,
for he is good; his love endures
forever."

GRATEFUL

REFLECT

God is good all the time!

This verse reminds us that no matter what happens, we can always thank God because His love never stops. Even when days are hard, His love keeps going and going. Being grateful means saying "Thank You" not just for what we get, but for who God is. When we thank God, it changes how we feel inside - it fills our hearts with joy instead of worry. When we start each day with gratitude, it's like planting a seed with happiness that grows bigger throughout the day. As we begin our 21 day journey, we start by being grateful, because every good thing begins with a thankful heart.

RESPOND:

What is one thing you can thank God for right now? How can you show a thankful attitude at home or at school today?

PRAYER:

Dear God, thank You for being good and loving me every single day. Help me to see all the good things You've given me and to say "thank You" more often. Fill my heart with joy and thankfulness. Amen

PRAYER FOCUS:

Pray that you will remember to thank God in every situation, even when things are tough.

DAY 02

Matthew 5:16, NKJV

"Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven."

READY

REFLECT

Jesus wants us to shine like bright lights in the world! When we are ready, we show God's love through the way we act, speak, and help others. Being ready doesn't mean having everything figured out—it means being willing to do what God asks, anytime and anywhere. Maybe that means helping a friend, sharing what you have, or standing up for what's right. When you do things with love, people see Jesus shining through you. Every day is a chance to show that light!

RESPOND:

What's one way you can shine for Jesus today? Who can you help or encourage.

PRAYER:

Dear Jesus, help me to be ready to shine for You today. Show me how to love others and bring You glory through what I say and do. Thank You for helping me be Your light in the world.

Amen.

PRAYER FOCUS:

Pray that you will be ready each day to show God's love wherever you go.

DAY 03

Psalm 86:11; NIV

"Teach me your ways, Lord,
that I may rely on your faithfulness;
give me an undivided heart, that I
may fear your name."

REFLECT

Being open means letting God teach you and help you grow.

Sometimes we think we know what's best, but God always knows better. He wants our hearts to be open and ready to listen to Him. When we let pride or stubbornness get in the way, it's like closing the door to God's voice. But when we stay open—ready to listen, learn, and change—God shows us the best way to go. He loves when we trust Him with all our heart!

OPEN



RESPOND:

What's one thing you can ask God to help you learn this week? How can you keep your heart open to what He says?

PRAYER:

Dear Lord, teach me Your ways and help me listen to You. Take away anything that makes me stubborn or afraid. Keep my heart open to You every day. Amen.

PRAYER FOCUS:

Pray for an open heart that listens to God's voice and follows His ways.

DAY 04

Isaiah 1:19, NKJV

"If you are willing and obedient, you shall eat the good of the land."

WILLING

REFLECT

God loves when we obey Him with a happy heart! It's not just about doing the right thing—it's about

wanting to do it. When we obey willingly, we show that we trust God's way is best. Sometimes God asks us to do things that are hard, like forgiving someone or sharing when we don't feel like it. But when we say "Yes, Lord," with a smile, we make God proud and open the door to His blessings. A willing heart is a happy heart!

RESPOND:

What is something God wants you to do that's been hard to obey? How can you do it with a good attitude this time?

PRAYER:

Dear God, help me to obey You with joy and not just because I have to. Teach me to say "yes" to You quickly and with a happy heart. I know that when I obey, You bless me. Amen.

PRAYER FOCUS:

Pray for a cheerful heart that obeys God right away and with love.

DAY 05

Psalm 92:12, NIV

“The righteous will flourish like a palm tree, they will grow like a cedar of Lebanon.”

G.R.O.W.

REFLECT

God wants us to grow strong in our faith, just like tall trees! Palm trees and cedars grow deep roots that help them stay strong even in storms. When we stay close to God through prayer, worship, and kindness, we grow too! G.R.O.W. reminds us to be Grateful for what we have, Ready to do what God says, Open to learn from Him, and Willing to serve Him with joy. When we grow in these ways, God helps us stand tall and strong every day.



RESPOND:

What's one way you can G.R.O.W. this week? Which part—Grateful, Ready, Open, or Willing, do you want to work on most?

PRAYER:

Dear God, thank You for helping me grow like a strong tree that loves You. Teach me to be grateful, ready, open, and willing each day. Help me stay close to You and grow stronger in my faith. Amen.

PRAYER FOCUS:

Pray that you will keep growing stronger in your faith and stay rooted in God's love.

DAY 06

1 Thessalonians 5:16–18, NLT
“Always be joyful. Never stop praying. Be thankful in all circumstances.”

GRATEFUL

REFLECT

God wants us to say “thank You”...
not just when things go our way, but all the time! When we thank God, it reminds us that He's with us—even when days are hard. You can thank Him for sunshine and snacks, but also for lessons and challenges. Gratitude is like a superpower that helps us see God's love everywhere!

RESPOND:

What's one thing you can thank God for right now—even if it didn't go the way you wanted?

PRAYER:

Dear God, thank You for loving me every day. Help me remember to say “thank You” in both happy and tough times. Fill my heart with joy that doesn't depend on what's happening around me. Amen.

PRAYER FOCUS:

Ask God to help you be thankful every day, no matter what kind of day it is.

DAY 07

Matthew 25:13, NIV
“Therefore keep watch,
because you do not know the
day or the hour.”

OPEN

REFLECT

Being “ready” for Jesus means keeping our hearts open and doing what’s right—even when no one’s watching. Imagine your teacher showing up for a surprise test. If you’ve been paying attention, you’re ready! God wants us to be ready, too—ready to help others, forgive quickly, and share His love.

RESPOND:

How can you show you’re ready to follow Jesus today? Maybe by being kind, helping at home, or praying for a friend?

PRAYER:

Lord, help me be ready to do what You ask. Show me ways to shine Your light every day.
Amen.

PRAYER FOCUS:

Pray for a heart that’s ready to say “yes” to God right away.
