COVID-19 Preparedness (Revised 3/18/21)

If anyone in the congregation **tests positive for COVID-19**, who had been on the church premises in the <u>last 14 days</u>, the following steps shall be taken:

- 1. We encourage the individual to self-report a positive test for COVID-19 to Pastor Todd Wallen (cell number 513-470-1246)
- 2. Diagnoses of any kind is personal and will only be released by the individual
- 3. Communication will be sent to the church congregation via text or phone call with notification that a person has been diagnosed with COVID-19
- 4. If the church has been exposed, we will seek to follow Ohio and CDC guidelines. The board will consult and determine next steps utilizing known information on a case-by-case situation
- 5. Request the individual not to return to the church until they have met CDC's criteria to discontinue home isolation
- 6. The church will be cleaned and sanitized

If anyone in the congregation has been **exposed to someone who tests positive for COVID-19**, the following steps shall be taken:

- 1. We encourage the individual to self-report to Pastor Todd Wallen (cell number 513-470-1246) if you have been in close contact to someone who tests positive for COVID-19, have not received a negative COVID-19 test result, and have been on church premises in the last 14 days
- 2. Close contact includes:
 - a. Living in the same household as a sick person with COVID-19
 - b. Caring for a sick person with COVID-19
 - c. Being within 6 feet of a sick person with COVID-19 for 10 minutes, or
 - d. Being in direct contact with secretions from a sick person with COVID-19
- 3. Diagnoses of any kind is personal and will only be released by the individual
- 4. Communication will be sent to the church congregation via text or phone call with notification that a person has been exposed to someone who tested positive for COVID-19
- 5. Request the individual not to return to the church until they have met CDC's criteria to discontinue home isolation
- 6. The church will be cleaned and sanitized

If anyone in the congregation becomes sick **while on the church premises**, the following steps shall be taken:

- 1. An area in the church will be identified to separate anyone who exhibits symptoms of COVID-19
- 2. Ensure children are not left without adult supervision
- 3. Arrange to safely transport the individual to their home or a healthcare facility
- 4. Advise the congregation that an individual was exhibiting symptoms and suggest those with exposure to self-monitor for symptoms
- 5. Advise the congregation with symptoms or who have tested positive for COVID-19 not to return to the church until they have met CDC's criteria to discontinue home isolation
- 6. The remainder of the service will be canceled
- 7. The church will be cleaned and sanitized
