

PREMARITAL APPLICATION PACKET

Dear Engaged Couple:

Congratulations on your engagement! Thank you for choosing an Emmanuel Baptist Church pastor to serve you in working toward success in your upcoming marriage. To help us best serve you, as well as to help you expedite the process, we have compiled this packet with information and forms that are necessary to facilitate premarital counseling and reservation of the church facility (if applicable).

This packet includes:

- Premarital Application. Please return to EBC as soon as possible in order to begin the process. Do not
 let any of the questions intimidate you. They are only meant to help the pastor help you. There are
 questions that are personal and possibly difficult to answer. Because marriage is very personal, being
 candid on these questions will help set your marriage up for success.
- Pastoral Counseling Confidentiality form. Please return this with the Premarital Application.
- EBC Building Use Policy and Application. Please return this with the above forms if you desire to use Emmanuel for your wedding location.
- Article: Should We Get Married? Five "Pre-engagement" Questions to Ask Yourself. This is an article for you two to go through together while you wait for your application to process. Read it together and discuss the questions at the end of each section together. This will help you to start thinking through some of the issues we will cover in premarital counseling. This does not need to be returned.

Please note:

- We require premarital counseling for all couples in order to be married by a pastor from Emmanuel. Not only does premarital counseling make couples 31% less likely to divorce, but in the state of Minnesota, 12 hours of premarital counseling allows for a significant discount for your marriage license.
- Once the applications are received, please allow 1-2 weeks for processing.
- Once they are processed, you will receive an email from the officiating/counseling pastor informing you of the application status and further instructions.

PREMARITAL GUIDELINES

- All couples must go through premarital counseling in order for a staff pastor to officiate a wedding. If the
 counseling is not through that pastor, contact must be made from the counselor to the officiating pastor.
 The counseling material and required counseling sessions are subject to the individual
 pastor/counselor's preference.
- All couples must be legally divorced from prior marriages and currently single.
- Couples must strive to abstain from sexual activity during the engagement. More on this will be discussed with the pastor officiating the wedding.
- All couples will complete the required amount of premarital counseling sessions assigned by the pastor/counselor.
- All couples must complete the homework *prior* to the counseling appointment.
- The Emmanuel pastoral staff and the Board of Stewards of Emmanuel have the right to decline this application based on the conviction of biblical principles.
