We show love to God by:

- Talking to Him: continue to grow in prayer as discussed in the 4 year old content
- Giving to Him: We give to God by giving to our church. Provide your child with some offering envelopes and some money to give to God each week.
- Reading His Word: Read from a Bible story book each day
- Going to Church: Regularly attend Sunday School and worship
- Obeying Him: Doing what the Bible says

- Participate in collections at church such as
 Operation Christmas Child shoe boxes, angel
 tree, and Good Samaritan. Let children help you
 shop for the items that are being collected. Let
 the child bring the items to church and put in the
 designated collection spot.
- Do something to help a neighbor: rake leaves, bake cookies, etc.
- Clean your closets giving used clothing and toys to less fortunate families or organizations that support families in need.
