Manchester School of the Arts is a ministry of First Baptist Church offering instruction in music. Private lessons are held at First Baptist Church, taught by qualified and dedicated teachers.

## **Private Instruction: (\*\*children and adults)**

- \*Piano \*Voice \*Organ (piano experience needed) \*Accordion
- \*Woodwinds (flute, clarinet, saxophone) \*Musical Theater
- \*Brass (trumpet, trombone, tuba, french horn) \*Drums, Percussion

### **Tuition:**

- A \$25.00 non-refundable registration fee must accompany your registration form. You will not be scheduled with a teacher until the form and the fee are submitted.
- Tuition for one half-hour Private lesson/week: \$400.00/semester.
  - o Fall Semester has 16 lessons, Spring Semester has 17 lessons.
  - Tuition may be paid in <u>5 payments of \$80.00 each month</u> of the semester, OR <u>4 payments of \$100.00</u>, payable the first 4 months of the semester.
- Please make checks payable to Manchester School of the Arts.
- **Tuition is due on the first lesson of the month**. Payments may be placed in the box located outside the Director's office (across from the Choir Room.)

#### **Schedule:**

- Fall Semester: August 7 December 11.
   Spring Semester: January 8 May 10.
- When we receive your registration, you will be scheduled with a teacher, who will then contact you to arrange lesson time and day.

<sup>\*\*</sup>We recommend that children be at least 6 years old and able to read.

- **Absences:** Your teacher commits to being present and on time for the weekly lesson. Refunds cannot be given, and Make-up lessons cannot be guaranteed. If a student misses a lesson because of illness or emergency, a make-up lesson can be requested and worked out with the teacher, as the teacher's schedule permits. Make-ups can be requested for illness or emergency only. Lessons that are canceled without prior notice from the student will not be made up.
- **Practice**: Studying an instrument or studying voice involves skills that take time and patience to learn. We recommend a minimum of a one-year commitment to your lessons. Students will see growth when they commit to regular practice at home.
