

2018-19 B Team (BCM Leadership Team)

BCM exists to equip students who will reduce lostness and brokenness in the world. The BCM seeks to accomplish this by making disciples who will worship the Lord with gladness, live a missional lifestyle, share Christ to a lost and broken world, build a healthy community, and equip leaders for kingdom purpose. This is our purpose and guide for ministry at the UGA BCM. We realize that relationships and community are the key ways contemporary emerging adults (ages 18-29) grow in their faith. As a result, the BCM program is strategically structured to nurture and grow disciples who reproduce through reaching their peers with the good news of God's love only found in Jesus.

B Team Responsibilities (All B Team Members)

- Maintain a personal and growing relationship with Christ that results in a missional lifestyle
- Be involved in a local church
- B Team members should be present each Tuesday night at Gathering (large group worship service) and are strongly encouraged to be in a DawgPack
- Be involved with a small group through BCM and/or your church
- Attend all of the following:
 - New Leadership Training: April 10 & 17, 5:30-7:30pm
 - Spring Leadership Retreat: April 20-21, 2018
 - *August Leadership Retreat: August 5-8, 2018
 - Confluence: September 21-23, 2018
 - Dinner Theatre: March 1-3, 2019
- ***All B Team members are required to attend the August retreat in order to be eligible to serve.**
- Meet on Tuesdays at 7:30pm for prayer before Gathering
- Meet monthly with entire leadership team (1st Tuesday of month at 6pm) for dinner, fellowship, planning, and communication
- Once every 5-6 weeks, your team will be assigned parking lot duty (you will check the parking once during that week)
- Agree to comply with the Beliefs and Lifestyle Statement (on application)

These responsibilities are the minimum requirements for leadership positions. Other responsibilities will be assigned throughout the year by Campus Ministers.

All B Team members will be required to pay \$200 in leadership dues.

Leadership dues help offset costs for leadership retreats, meals at monthly meetings, and other expenses.

Connectors Responsibilities

- Responsible for managing, in conjunction with assigned campus minister, their ministry's budget
- Recruit volunteers for their respective ministry
- Meet weekly with assigned campus minister
- Meet monthly with connectors team and campus ministers (3rd Tuesday of month at 6pm)
- Collaborate with coordinators and volunteers to accomplish goals of your ministry area

B Team interviews will be held on March 28 at 6pm.

Job Descriptions

President

- Lead peers by example of reducing lostness and brokenness on campus
- Serve, encourage, and invest in the lives of the connectors
- Act as a catalyst for helping people in BCM connect with ministries to serve in
- Facilitate all leadership and connectors meetings
- Must be an active member of a Southern Baptist church
- Must have previously served two years on leadership team (one year can be at another BCM)

Discipleship Team

Purpose: to create an environment where believers become more mature in their faith and also, where non-believers can meet Jesus

¹¹ So Christ himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, ¹² to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up ¹³ until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.

¹⁴ Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of people in their deceitful scheming. ¹⁵ Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ. ¹⁶ From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work.

Discipleship Connectors (Guy and Girl)

- Work closely with other discipleship connector to lead the discipleship team (DawgPack leaders and prayer coordinator) in maintaining a culture of discipleship
- Lead men's/women's ministry for the BCM community
- Participate in discipleship training at leadership retreats
- Adequately invest in guy/girl DawgPack leaders and equip them to disciple their students
- Assist DP leaders in securing strategic meeting places around campus and the community for easy entry points for non-members (including lost students and those not involved in a ministry)
- Meet monthly with each guy/girl DawgPack leader individually and monthly with discipleship team
- Work closely with supervising Campus Minister and other discipleship connector to maintain a working relationship with DP coaches
- Work with other discipleship connector to assist leaders in recruiting students for their DawgPacks
- Work with other discipleship connector to maintain weekly DawgPack rolls
- Must have previously served as a DawgPack leader

DawgPack Leader

- Prepare and teach DawgPack group
- Meet with DP members individually and as a group for fellowship and support
- Meet monthly with DP coaches, discipleship connector, and supervising campus minister

Prayer Coordinator

- Promote and maintain a culture of prayer in the entire BCM
- Plan opportunities to gather and pray during the week
- Plan and implement a prayer workshop
- Provide guided prayers and other materials in the prayer room

Fellowship Team

Purpose: to create an atmosphere for building relationships and community in the effort to reduce lostness and brokenness

⁴⁶ Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, ⁴⁷ praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

Fellowship Connector

- Lead the events team (freshmen, transfers, seniors, hospitality & RFC coordinators and DT director) to work together to plan and coordinate fellowship events, including Open House, Ride for Christ, Confluence, Formal, Semi-Formal, and events specifically for freshmen, seniors, and transfers
- Plan Spring Leadership Retreat in conjunction with campus ministers
- Help plan & coordinate other special events throughout the year (workshops, retreats, etc.)

Freshmen Coordinator

- Serve as a part of the fellowship planning team
- Work with the fellowship connector to plan and to conduct a few social events each semester to which BCM students can invite freshmen friends and classmates
- Recruit a crew of volunteers to help plan, set-up/clean-up, and host events
- Work with freshmen DawgPack leaders to plan social events

Transfers Coordinator

- Serve as a part of the fellowship planning team
- Work with the fellowship connector and transfer DP leaders to plan and conduct a few social events each semester to which BCM students can invite friends and classmates who are also transfer student
- Assist transfer students in getting involved with BCM
- Recruit a crew of volunteers to help plan, set-up/clean-up, and host events

Seniors Coordinator

- Serve as a part of the fellowship planning team
- Work with the fellowship connector to plan and conduct a few social events each semester for Seniors
- Plan a few informational events each semester on topics related to concerns of graduating seniors and post-collegiate life
- Work with the supervising campus minister to plan fall and spring senior recognitions
- Work with the UGA BCM Alumni Foundation president to plan and conduct the annual senior dinner before spring graduation
- Work with campus minister to plan and promote senior spring break mission trip
- Recruit a crew of volunteers to help plan, set-up/clean-up, and host events

(Fellowship Team Continued)

Hospitality Coordinator

- Serve as a part of the fellowship planning team
- Work with the fellowship connector and supervising campus minister to plan and organize hospitality needs for events (including facility set-up, recruiting volunteers, and food needs/preparation)
- Help plan and organize BCM tailgates for designated football games
- Work with the Dinner Theatre director and supervising campus minister to plan and implement the dining room atmosphere for the show
- Recruit and coordinate volunteers to serve during DT

Ride for Christ Coordinator

- Serve as a part of the fellowship planning team
- Work with the fellowship connector and supervising campus minister in the spring to recruit a RFC planning team
- Keep the dual purpose of RFC before the BCM (to raise funds for SendMeNow and for outreach and building community with those who might rise to this extreme challenge)
- Work with the planning team to plan, organize and conduct RFC (including training rides/events, publicity, sponsors, fundraising, drivers, encouragement, host churches, etc.)

Dinner Theatre Director

- Serve as a part of the fellowship planning team
- Work with the supervising campus minister to select a positive, family-friendly show, select a team (music director, assistant director, choreographer, etc.), and develop a budget to raise the highest amount of money possible for SendMeNow
- Create the spiritual climate of the group
- Plan and lead auditions for DT in the late fall, recruiting from within BCM and from the UGA community as an outreach
- Plan and lead rehearsals in January and February
- Help keep the BCM (prop room, shed, stage, etc.) organized before, during, and after the show

Missions Team

Purpose: to equip and send collegians to share the Gospel beyond UGA's campus

¹⁸ "The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free, ¹⁹ to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor."

Missions Connector

- Lead the missions team (internationals, local missions & missions day coordinators) to keep missions education and awareness before the BCM
- Promote SendMeNow missions opportunities and fundraisers to the BCM body
- Participate in spring break mission trip planning
- Would be best if Missions Connector has served through SendMeNow

Internationals Coordinator

- Serve as a part of the missions planning team
- Work with the missions connector to plan and conduct a comprehensive outreach ministry to international students attending UGA
 - Recruit other students to be involved in internationals ministry
 - Create and organize social events for international and American students, working with the PR team and supervising campus minister to publicize events
 - Attend International Coffee Hour each week to meet and build relationships with international students
 - Attend, promote, and organize participation in state international ministry events
 - Help assimilate international students into other BCM ministries and fellowships
 - Meet with the International Student Life (ISL) Director as needed to continue a positive relationship between BCM and ISL

Local Missions Coordinator

- Serve as a part of the missions planning team
- Work with the supervising campus minister to identify, select, and publicize ministry opportunities with strategic partners at UGA, in local churches, and within the greater Athens community (such as weekly ministries with Nellie B community, homeless ministries, etc., as well as other events such as fall festivals, food drive, etc.)
- Help coordinate participation in Backpacks for Appalachia

Missions Day Coordinator

- Serve as a part of the missions planning team
- Work with the supervising campus minister and the missions team to plan, organize, publicize and orchestrate a missions day in the community and local churches each semester

Outreach Team

Purpose: because of salvation and joy we have received, we are compelled to share the Good News with our peers

¹⁴ For Christ's love compels us, because we are convinced that one died for all, and therefore all died.

Outreach Connector

- Lead the outreach team (on-campus, greeters, and intramurals coordinators) in planning and coordinating events to reduce lostness in the UGA community
- Plan, coordinate, and implement DawgFest events in August and January
- Keep outreach opportunities before the BCM
- Plan and coordinate a few BCM-wide outreach events, including Engage 24
- Coordinate and recruit volunteers for community events (Connect 3on3 Basketball tournament, half marathons, 5K's, etc.)

On-Campus Coordinator

- Serve as a part of the outreach team
- Promote and recruit students to be involved with on-campus outreach events
- Work with outreach connector and campus minister to find creative ways of reaching students on campus
- Attend and coordinate "BCM on Campus" each week
- Assist outreach team with Engage 24 and DawgFest

Greeters Coordinator

- Serve as a part of the outreach team
- Recruit and organize greeters for Tuesday night and BCM-wide events
- Work with outreach connector and campus minister to create a welcoming atmosphere within BCM

Intramurals Coordinator

- Serve as a part of the outreach team
- Recruit captains and coordinate teams for various intramural sports
- Keep outreach mindset among teams by encouraging recruitment of non-BCM students on each team

Deaf Ministry Coordinator

- Organize interpreters for Tuesday worship services and other BCM events, including dinner theatre
- Help deaf students find a local church
- Help student interpreters find a local church in which to use their skills
- Organize and/or teach ASL classes
- Assist production team as needed in making worship services ASL-friendly

Public Relations Team

Purpose: to keep students informed about BCM and ministry opportunities so that the Gospel can be shared throughout campus

⁸ I am the least of all God's people. Yet, God showed me his kindness by allowing me to spread the Good News of the immeasurable wealth of Christ to people who are not Jewish. ⁹ He allowed me to explain the way this mystery works. PR Intern

- Lead the PR team (internal and external PR coordinators)
- Design and implement effective ways of communicating with BCM students, alumni, local churches, and students at UGA
- Keep BCM website updated throughout the year
- Document stories & pictures and put them on the BCM website and social media
- Meet weekly with administrative assistant
- Keep leadership team informed about the BCM calendar and details of upcoming events
- Work with administrative assistant on print media, social media, website & other communications
- Meet monthly with Connectors and campus ministers (3rd Tuesday of each month at 6pm)

**Leadership and parking fees do not apply to intern, but intern will pay to attend Confluence.*

Internal PR Coordinator

- Work within the PR team to create a marketing strategy for BCM
- Create weekly flyers with announcements to be distributed at each Gathering
- Develop creative ways to keep BCMers informed about BCM events and opportunities to serve
- Create posters and other means of communication to advertise within the BCM
- Work with PR team to document stories and pictures for the website and social media

External PR Coordinator

- Work within the PR team to create a marketing strategy for BCM
- Develop creative ways to keep the campus informed about the BCM and specific events
- Create and distribute flyers and posters around campus to advertise BCM and specific events
- Work with PR team to document stories and pictures for the website and social media

Production Team

Purpose: to create authentic worship through an environment that enriches the lives of believers, reaches the lost, and heals the broken-hearted

¹Shout happily to the LORD, all the earth. ²Serve the LORD cheerfully. Come into his presence with a joyful song. ³Realize that the LORD alone is God. He made us, and we are his.^[a] We are his people and the sheep in his care. ⁴Enter his gates with a song of thanksgiving. Come into his courtyards with a song of praise. Production Connector

- Lead the production team (band leader, sound technician, video production, hosts). The Production Connector is the representative for all of these elements and must be the central person to coordinate these efforts simultaneously.
- Research and implement creative elements into corporate worship and other BCM events, including but not limited to: providing videos to support or promote teaching or events, suggesting hands on or tangible object lessons, stage design, etc.
- Work with campus ministers at Spring and August retreats to plan Gathering for the year
- In close cooperation with the supervising campus minister and program personnel, coordinate each week's worship service in order to best communicate the lesson for the evening
- Coordinate and train tech team
- Assemble presentations in ProPresenter for weekly services, including lyrics, announcement slides, scripture, and other visual aids as needed (training in ProPresenter will be provided)
- Manage order of service for large group each week, including rehearsals and run-throughs
- Be responsible for and coordinate with worship bands and other elements of large group; including scheduling auditions as needed

Band Leader

- Work with campus ministers at Spring and August retreats to plan Tuesdays @ the B for the year
- Work with Production Connector and Campus Ministers to plan music for Tuesday night services throughout the year
- Meet regularly with worship bands, leading in rehearsals, involving large numbers of students, and focusing on spiritual growth.
- Work with Campus Minister and Production Connector to schedule band auditions as needed

(Production Team Continued)

Sound Technician

- Be present at all band rehearsals and run-throughs
- Be responsible for set up and maintenance of all equipment needed. Be prepared **before** rehearsals and run-throughs start (need attention to detail and organization skills)
- Provide support for video sound needs, click track needs of band, and recording of the service as needed.
- Report to Production Connector

Video Production

- Have knowledge of video production using a DSLR camera and video editing software (Premiere Pro or iMovie) (training can be provided if needed)
- Responsible for all elements relating to pre-production planning, production and post-production editing for videos needed for Tuesday @ the B
 - Videos will be short in nature – usually 3 minutes or less but are an important communication tool for the organization
 - Videos can be announcements for events, interviews to communicate a story, or even an element of worship
 - The vision/direction for these videos will come from campus ministers/BCM leadership so it is important to take direction to help communicate the larger vision of the organization
- Report to the Production Connector but works with PR committee for promotional videos

Impact Coordinator

- Work cooperatively with the production team and with the production connector
- Recruit a team compiled of drama, small group leaders, musicians, and speakers to send to churches as needed for DNOWs, revivals, retreats, worship services, etc.
- Assist supervising campus minister to communicate with churches and schedule dates and meet the needs of church events
