While in Haiti, our Mission Team will be working with **But God Ministries** and staying at the Hope Center in Galette Chambon. **But God Ministries** is developing **sustainable communities in Haiti and in the Delta in North Mississippi**. Ministries to the Haitian community include an orphanage, a church, water wells, houses, agricultural plots, and **The Hope Center** which houses medical and dental clinics, air-conditioned dorms for visiting missionary teams, and more. The team will: ***Help missionaries Tony and Mickie West with ministry needs * Lead a ladies' Bible study and craft time *Minister to orphans *Ministry, evangelism visits *Child Sponsorship Program Outreach.**

Prayer Requests for the Mission Team:

- 1. That all that is said and done will bring glory to God. (Colossians 3:17,23)**
- 2. That God will accomplish His purpose: in each participant, family member, and those they meet along the way. Pray they will not miss divine appointments. (Psalm 138:8, Ephesians 6:19)**
