In the weeks ahead your teenager will learn about the greatest commandment in the Bible, how to love those who are hard to love, how Jesus said we are to treat society's outcasts, and why living a life of Godly love is so important.

Advertisers and today's celebrities are quick to get teenagers to buy into their image of love and relating to others, usually for financial profit and rarely in sync with what the Bible says about such issues.
