Getting started

Discussion

Read the passage and answer the following questions as a group.

Jesus said nothing to the mocking criminal, but could've humiliated the man and been completely justified. As the body of Christ, how can we learn from Jesus' example?

How does the difference between the two criminals show us a picture of God's heart?

Jesus, showing the second criminal mercy, put aside everything that happened to Him and instead put a bad situation to good use. What can we take away from this story to use in our own lives when we experience difficult situations?
