ELDER UPDATE

Elder Communication for the April 2023 Newsletter

The Elder Council met on March 14th. The Elders present were Brett Hansen, Bobby Thomas, David Torbert, Luke Miller. and Randy Scott. Nolan Callaway and Dave Christenson joined virtually. Staff present were Jimmy Long and Kevin Smith. Luke Miller led the devotion from Romans 6. February meeting notes were approved as submitted.

Financial Summary

The elders reviewed the January Financial Statement. The elders discussed the recent Silicon Valley Bank collapse and implications that might result from this collapse as regional banks come under additional pressure. The elders agreed to ask the Financial Team to discuss and provide a recommendation back to the elder council regarding any changes to our current banking practices.

Family Assignments and Prayer Concerns

The elders entered into a time of discussion of needs and prayer for the church body. The elders also discussed reactivating/reestablishing the Membership Restoration Team to reach out to those members who are no longer active.

Staff Reports

Jimmy Long - Senior Pastor

Planning is in full swing for Easter weekend. Our Evangelism/Outreach Team has taken the lead in scheduling a Community Egg Hunt. The event will take place on the Saturday before Easter from 10:00–11:30 am. In addition to the egg hunt, there will be activities like cookie decorating, and the plan is to have the Kona Ice truck here to treat all our guests. Of course, the heart of Easter is the resurrection of Jesus, and we will share that story with all the families who attend. This event will require the whole church join in by providing pre-filled candy eggs and volunteering.

On Easter Sunday, we will have a sunrise service communion service at 7:00am under the pavilion. The Dominican Republic Mission Team will provide a pancake breakfast before small group time, and donations will be accepted for those wishing to help the team members on the trip. In addition to a worship service celebrating the victory of Jesus, we will have a spot for families to take photos that day.

I have been working closely with the search teams seeking our two new staff positions. I am grateful for their commitment to prayer and their diligence is seeking out and evaluating candidates. Kevin Smith has been instrumental in helping us get job descriptions to the various institutions and outlets. I am deeply grateful for the prayers of the Grace family as we move forward in faith.

Our church and denomination are during our Easter Offering Emphasis named for Annie Armstrong. Our church goal is \$8000, and we hope to exceed this goal by Easter Sunday. All the funds raised through this offering go directly to missions efforts in North American with no associated overhead costs. In addition to the offering, we will have weekly video promotions in the worship services and a prayer guide has been made available.

The message series for January focused on our mission, vision, and strategy. It was here that the newly revised strategic plan was shared with the church at large.
