
# GRACE @ HOME BOOK GIVEAWAY

# ELDER UPDATE

#### **Elder Communication for the January 2024 Newsletter**

The regular Elder meeting was held on Tuesday, December 12th. David Torbert led the devotion, and this was followed by the approval of both the minutes of the November meeting and the report from the Finance Team. As we do each month, the elders then entered a time of discussion for the known prayer needs of our membership as well as the needs of each elder.

Treasurer Melvin Rhodes and Finance Team Chair Larry Choate were in attendance at the meeting to answer any questions about the draft 2024 budget. There was a lot of productive discussion, and we appreciate the work of the ministry teams, Finance Teams, staff, and Treasurer in putting this budget together. The Elder Council will finalize this budget and share it with the church in mid-January in preparation for our vote on the budget in our Annual Meeting on January 28. Prior to this, the Elders and Finance Team will provide a Q&A session the week prior to that Annual Meeting.

Pastor Jimmy reported on the ongoing work of the Master Planning Team that is currently at work helping us develop the actions steps to move Grace Fellowship forward. The plan is to have a draft plan to submit to the Elder Council in the first quarter of 2024. In addition, staff goals for the coming year are being set based on the strategic plan, however these goals may need to be adjusted once the Master Plan is completed and approved.

Our Children's Ministry Director Cassidy Callaway presented a report on the updates the nursery and children's hall. The children's rooms were all painted the week before Thanksgiving. New decorations have been purchased, and each room has a unique theme. All the children's curriculum has been reviewed and revisions have been made. Please continue to be in prayer for this vital ministry.

Pastor Joey reported on several important Discipleship events that occurred over the past month. We successfully launched our first Impact group, and plan to develop disciples who make disciples. We also introduced a prototype for an "in-home affinity group" with a strategic plan to evolve it into a "HOST" home, specifically targeting non-church attenders. The initial response to this indicates potential for meaningful community outreach. Six families from around the area have made commitments to this, and this will move forward in January.

# ELDER UPDATE

Pastor Joey has begun recording and editing video-based lessons for Right Now Media to enhance the quality and accessibility of discipleship materials, as well as, produce our very own material specifically for Grace Fellowship. Finally, the Youth Ministry reported they have successfully completed "Section 1: Creation" of the Youth curriculum and transitioned into the new "Section 2: Fall." The continuity in curriculum development ensures a comprehensive and cohesive learning experience for our Youth.

Pastor Matt reported that weekly choir rehearsals are back underway and noted that if anyone is interested in participating in our choir to contact him. In addition, with Christmas Eve falling on Sunday this year, the church staff determined the best schedule for that day would be to cancel Sunday morning Small Groups, have our fellowship time at 10:00 a.m. and the worship service at the regular 10:30 a.m. time. This year we will have only one Christmas Eve Candlelight service at 5:00 p.m. We look forward to celebrating the birth of our Savior together this year in both our morning worship and our Candlelight service!

The Elder Council and Pastor Jimmy are working on finalized plans for Pastor Jimmy's sabbatical, which is scheduled for August-October of next year. This time will be in part to rest, reflect, and restore, but also to prepare for the 2025 sermon series. This will include personal study, commentary study, and at least one conference, in addition to some time for rest and refreshment. Sabbaticals are provided to pastoral staff who have served for at least 7 years at Grace Fellowship.

Lastly, we are happy to report that we will be presenting 4 candidates to begin a new 3-year term as elder beginning in January. Candidate testimonies will begin December 31st and continuing into January, with a vote to affirm in our conference on January 28th. Please be in prayer for these men as they begin this important service. The candidates to be presented are Stuart Harris, Tom Lynn, Mac Manley, and Mike Moore.

We would like to thank Luke Miller and Bobby Thomas for their service to Grace Fellowship as they rotate off. Their final meeting will be in January.
