

Pastor Jimmy prayed for the names and needs on the list, as well the needs of each Elder and his family.

Pastor Jimmy reported that with the addition of Matthew MacLeod as our Worship and Community Outreach Pastor and Josef Wood as our Discipleship Pastor, we are excited to see where God will take us. # ELDER UPDATE

Pastor Matt MacLeod reported that the majority of my first month was focused on getting settled, specifically in the areas of worship and production. I jumped right into planning and preparing for services as Sundays come around weekly new guy or not. It was a great help to have Michael McGough overlap for a couple weeks and connect with him. I have also been able to meet with Michael Wells. I will keep both Michaels in mind if questions arise.

In the area of Community Ministry, Matt spoke with Deborah Miller regarding supporting the missions team as needed with a meeting set later in August. A few notable items in the next couple months will include ministry team meet and greets, calendar planning through year end, vision planning for 2024, and beginning to connect with local missions.

Pastor Joey Wood and his family have moved into their new home last week and are getting settled into the area. He reported that has met with all youth volunteers and is looking to add new volunteers to the youth ministry.

Administrative Coordinator Kevin Smith informed the Elders of his continued work on the revision of the finance policy. He is looking forward to working with the additional new team members. They are coming on board just in time to begin the 2024 Proposed Budget.

In the area of Child Safety, revisions to the Children's Ministry Policy have been made and a draft copy was provided by the Elders. Next step is working with Joey Wood to review and give input prior to seeking final approval of the new policy from Elders. Kevin also reported on the progress of several items related to the building that are currently being pursued.

Bobby Thomas provided a report from the Financial Review Team for 2022. The report was reviewed and approved, and items recommended by the FRT will be considered and actions taken. In addition, an number of other items related to ministry were discussed and appropriate delegation was made to continue to move forward.
