

Preschool/Nursery Policies & Procedures



Our goal is to provide a safe and loving environment for all preschoolers (birth to 5yrs). Caring and experienced teachers will lay a foundation for faith in Jesus by providing for the physical and spiritual needs of each child.

Please bring any bottles, sippy cups, baby food, formula, diapers, wipes and any other necessary items for your child. Your child's bag will not be brought into the class rooms, but will instead be placed in the hall and accessed if needed. We have diapers, wipes, and latex-free gloves to ensure safe diaper changing in our nursery. Each room is stocked with plenty of hand sanitizer, disinfecting wipes, disinfecting cleaner, and a sink/soap/step stool in our toddler and preschool classrooms to ensure proper hygiene. We also have pre-packaged snacks and a select amount of toys for your little one. Sanitizing our toys after each use is a high priority in order to keep your child safe. Masks are not required but, if you decide that you would like for your child to keep a mask on, let us know and we will make sure that your child wears his/her mask. (*The CDC recommends that children under 2yrs of age NOT wear masks*)

Please make sure to give our Check-in attendant any and all information necessary for a safe experience in our Preschool/Nursery Ministry. Also, please allow your potty-trained child to use the restroom before checking in.

In order to keep our children healthy and safe, PLEASE DO NOT bring your child to the preschool/nursery area if they have ANY of the following symptoms:

- Fever–your child must be fever-free for a FULL 24 hours with no fever reducing medicine given in that 24 hour period.
- Vomiting or Diarrhea–your child must be free of these symptoms for 24 hours.
- ANY type of rash
- Inflamed throat and/or mouth
- Coughing and/or sneezing
- Head lice OR known exposure to head lice.
- Pink eye OR known exposure to pink eye
- Open wounds without bandages
- Childhood diseases (i.e. chicken pox, mumps, measles, etc.)

If you or your child has been exposed to someone who has tested positive for OR shows symptoms of coronavirus (Covid-19), please do NOT bring them to our Preschool/Nursery Ministry.
