MINISTRY

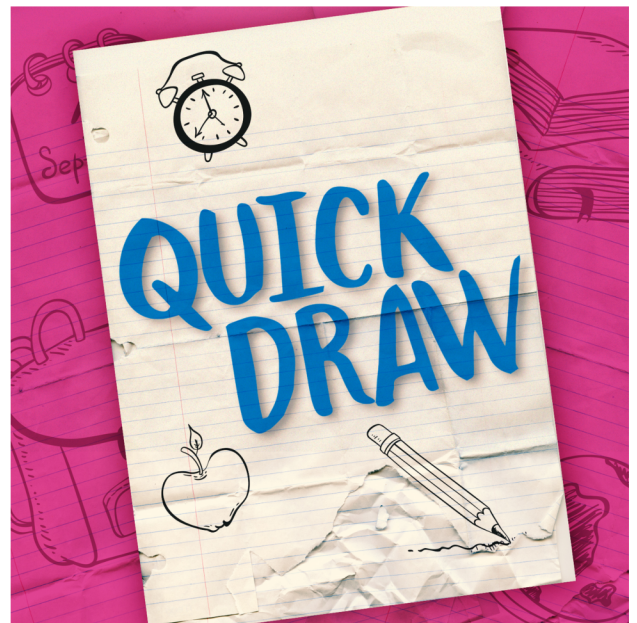
It's a joy and an honor to serve and teach your children each week. They have hungry minds and it's amazing to watch them learn and grow in the Lord.

ELDER UPDATE

The Elder Communication for the January 2026 Newsletter

The Elder Council met in their regular meeting on Tuesday, December 16, 2025. The Elders present were: Randy Scott, Stuart Harris, Mike Moore, Mac Manley, Steven Brondyke, David Tolbert, AJ Hunt, Nolan Callaway, Tom Lynn, and Pastor Jimmy Long. In addition, Matt Macleod, Joey Wood, and Hank Raehn were there representing the staff. Additionally, members of the Finance Team were present: Melvin Rhodes (Treasurer), Pam Scott (Asst Treasurer), and Larry Choate (Team Chair).

Randy Scott opened the meeting in prayer and a devotion. This was followed by reciting the church's mission statement that is to guide us in our work. The minutes from the November meeting were approved as submitted, and this was followed by the report from the Finance Team led by Mike Moore (Elder Liaison to the Finance Team).

Below is a summary of giving this month and year-to-date.

Giving Summary:

God has blessed us this year with faithful givers to enable us to accomplish so much each month. The Elders deeply appreciate the faithfulness of God's people and the efforts of our Finance Team!

The Elders entered a time of discussion for the known prayer needs of our membership, as well as the needs of each elder. Following this, Pastor Jimmy prayed for the names and needs as well as the Elders and his family.

The Elders considered a number of building repair and update priorities. The work to correct issues with the pavilion is underway, and an issue with some wood rot around some of the windows is being evaluated. Other priorities were discussed but will be addressed specifically in the near future.

Members of the Finance Team were present to assist with two important issues:

(1) Based on advice from the Finance Team, Pastor Jimmy recommended that \$75,000 be moved from the Georgia Baptist Foundation Fund to the General Fund in order to create a better balance between the accounts and to provide greater liquidity for the church. The motion was considered and passed. The Finance Team was instructed to proceed with this in January.

(2) The 2026 draft budget was considered in great detail. The final vote will be in January, but the Elders are committed to presenting to the church a budget that meets our ministry needs for the coming year. Additionally, once a final giving total for 2025 is known, the Elder Council will reconsider whether we are able to increase our giving to the Cooperative Program to boost what we gave this fiscal year. Please pray for this process.

The next scheduled Elder Council meeting is January 20. If there are any issues that you would like addressed, please contact any of the elders to request it be placed on our agenda.

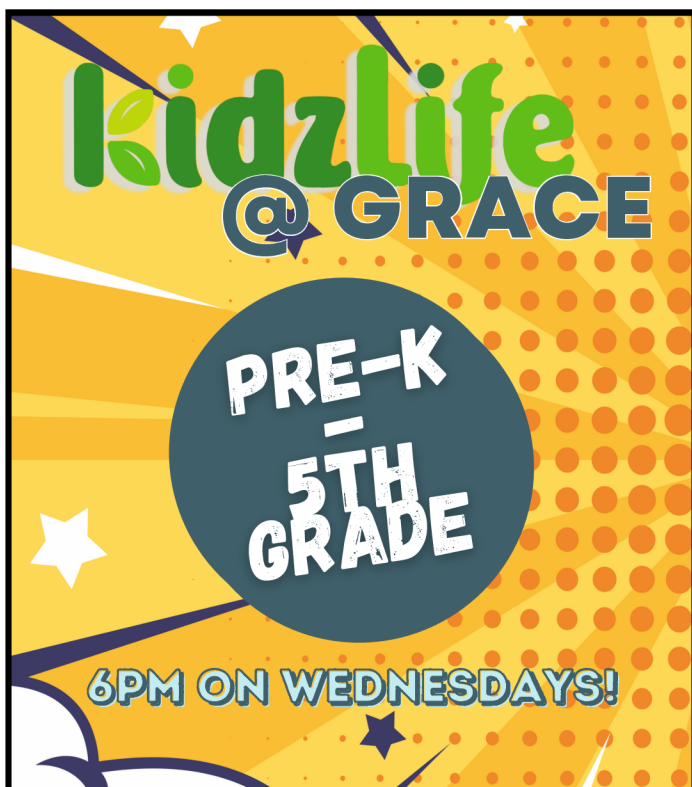

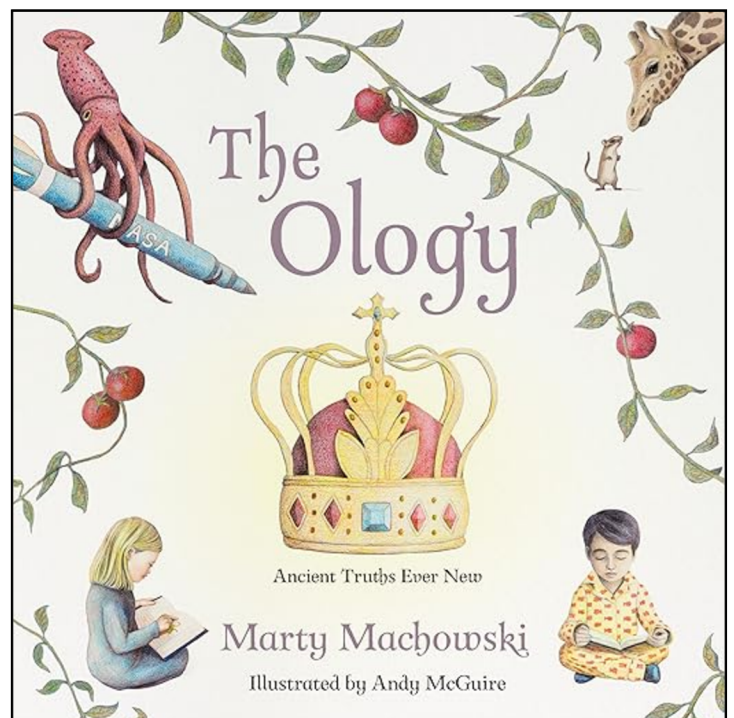
