No Evening Services on Sunday July 6

For the sixth time, God is giving FBC an opportunity to practice the Great Commission in our very own parking lot! In collaboration with the BCHS football program & FCA, we have the tremendous opportunity of hosting a Gospel-centered worship service in our backyard, so to speak. Incredible!! This event will not fatten our financial coffers, nor will it enlarge our membership rolls; this is a straight-up seed planting event. But I believe our faithfulness in responding to these divine moments positions our church in the waterfall of God's abundant blessing.

The FCA/football camp worship event is Tuesday night, July 15; the service will begin at 7:15. We're expecting 650 young men and coaches at this camp. There are many ways to serve because that is the foremost privilege we have @ this event - service. Listed below are the different ways you can serve with your hands & feet.

**First** — this is what we need from those of you who know your way around a kitchen.

Cookies!!! Any kind of cookie will work. We ask that you bag the cookies (3 to a bag) before you bring them to the church on Monday (July 14) ahead of the event. Jan Evans is overseeing this part of event preparation...call her if you have any questions. Keep in mind: we will be needing 2000 cookies for this occasion!

**Second** — there are several opportunities to serve with your hands and feet on the day of the event *(July 15th)*. So here's what the Tuesday schedule looks like:

- 8:00 am meet in the parking lot to unload and set-up 900 chairs, set-up greeting stations, fans/generators, etc. <u>Everyone is</u>
   <u>welcome to help with set-up: male/female, adult/students.</u> If a goodly number of you are able to come serve, this will not take a lot of time...I would think 1- 2 hours at the most
- 6:00 pm All those who will be serving during the actual event need to be @ the church by this time. If you can't make it by 6:00, come when you can! Men, women, students, and kids are welcome to serve. The eight football teams will begin arriving @ 6:45 and the service begins @ 7:15 pm.
- 8:30ish pm breakdown begins. Chairs will need to be loaded back on the trailer, fans/generators moved inside, greeting stations dismantled which will include moving the baptistry trough and taking down the pop-up tents, helping our worship leaders dismantle their stuff, and other sundry tasks which will need doing.

Last but not least — PRAY. This is the most powerful way you can serve. Pray that the Gospel seeds will land in open, willing hearts. Pray for the power of God's Holy Spirit to manifest in the preaching and singing of the Gospel. Pray that all the big & little preparation details will be covered, and that the weather will be perfect! Pray for an abundance of servants to show-up, greet, serve, and show the players the face of Jesus. Pray for the life trajectory of some of the young men in attendance to be changed for all of eternity as they respond to the Good News of Jesus Christ!
