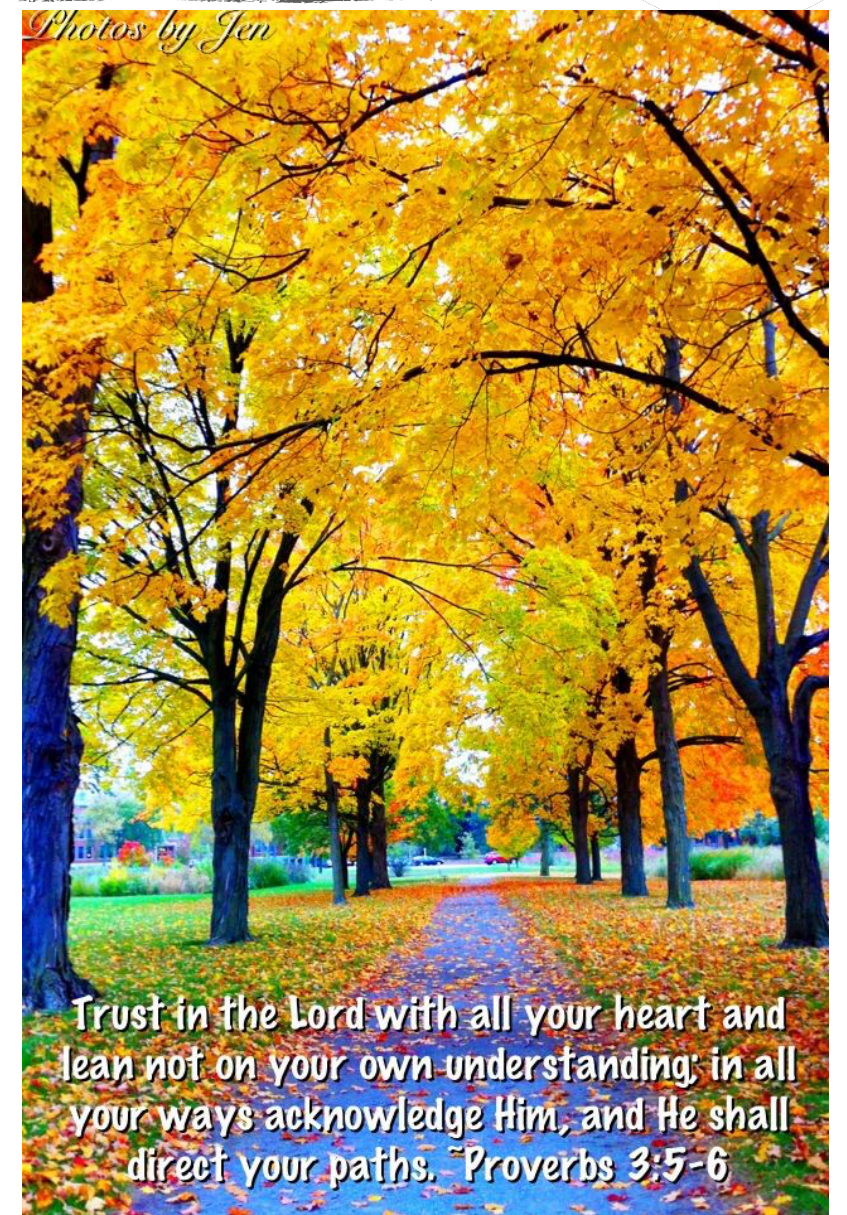

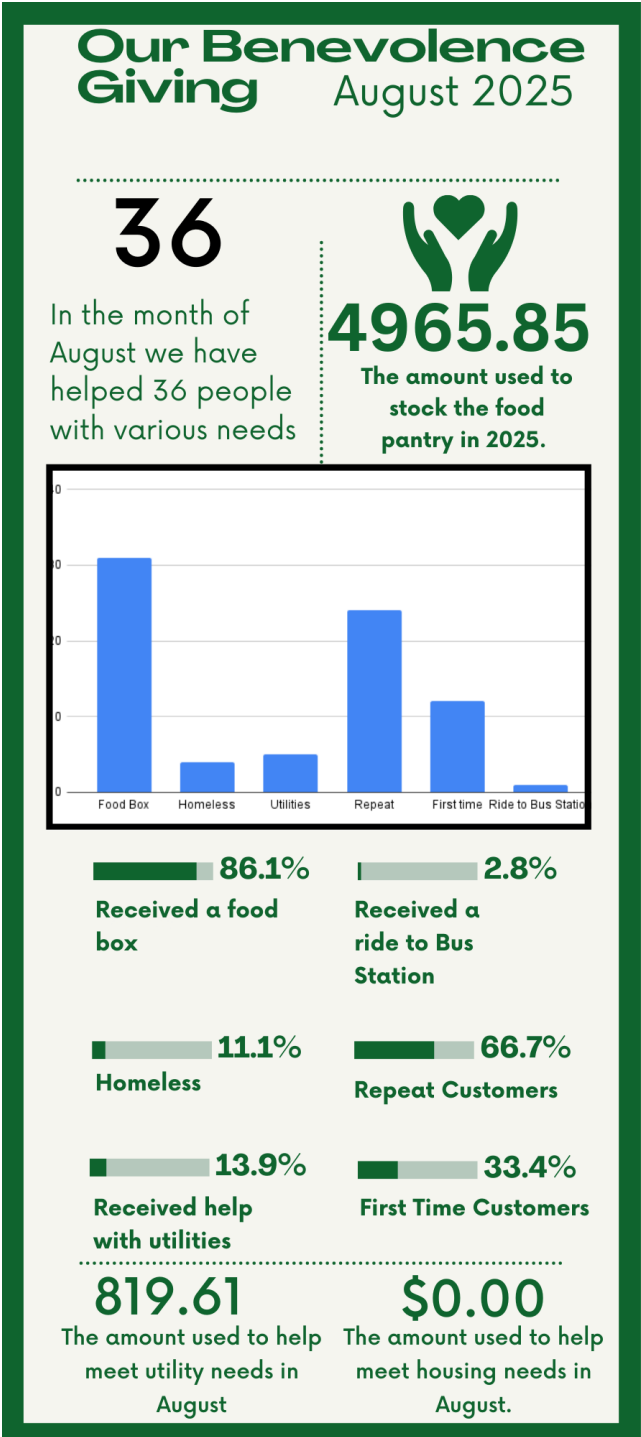

- Speaking words of grace & encouragement; abstaining from critical, judgmental words.
- Volunteering to serve when a ministry need is made known; demonstrating reliability in our volunteerism.
- Engaging guests with meaningful words and actions.

Mother Teresa once stated, “Be faithful in small things because it is in them that your strength lies.” Hudson Taylor wrote, “A little thing is a little thing, but faithfulness in little things is a great thing.” Consistently engaging little things with a passion to delight God transforms little things into powerful things!
