

To help our church family better understand and appreciate the many ways God is at work through our ministries, we are launching a weekly Ministry Spotlight. Each week, we will highlight one of our ministry Teams (previously known as Committees) or a stand-alone ministry, sharing its purpose, activities, and opportunities for involvement. Our hope is to increase awareness, celebrate those who serve, and encourage others to discover ways they can use their gifts to support the mission of our church.

Let us explore our **Family & Children's Ministry!**

What is their primary purpose? To reach the families of our community with the Gospel of Christ through regular activities, events, and Bible studies.

How does this ministry support the overall mission of FBC? By helping lead others (specifically within the context of a family) into a growing relationship with Christ.

What ministry accomplishments may be unknown to our church? The Family & Children's Ministry has been reaching our community through many different avenues. From having over 120 kids at VBS every day, to reaching community families through AWANA, and even growing our Sunday morning classes to where we need to add more!

Tell us something you would like our church to know. The Family & Children's Ministry has the opportunity to touch many more than just Children. Every age group has a connection through the families. There are many ways that one could be a part of Family & Children's Ministry and have an impact on the church and community as a whole!

What are some current projects they are working on? We are currently working on updating the classrooms and decluttering. This project is to make sure that we have rooms available for growth. This is a Summer Project so will be done over time before August. We also will be working to update our visitor experience so any help to make our visitor experience a smooth process would be helpful.

How can church members get involved? There are many ways:





- 1) Volunteer on a monthly/bi-monthly basis in many different classes with kids (Sunday Morning, Sunday Evening, Wednesday Evening)
- 2) Volunteer as a door greeter/security
- 3) Volunteer as transition director (transition times only)
- 4) Help by getting logistics and events prepped/broke down
- 5) Volunteer in a specific class (SS, AWANA, Bible Drills)

How can the congregation pray for this ministry? That we stay rooted in the Gospel and not be distracted by all the "new things" people think that we need. Also, pray for the families that we have been able to serve and that we can be a resource for their family to grow closer to Jesus! Finally, pray that we have more people to serve our families and kids. As we grow in numbers, we need more to share the love of Christ with these kids!
