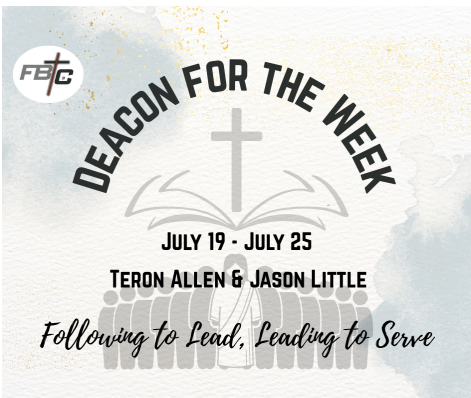

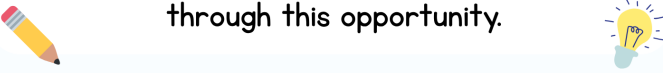


Our Next Ministry Opportunity Is Here!

What is their primary purpose? The purpose of Legacy Builders’ Ministry is to stimulate spiritual growth, Great Commission involvement, and to deepen the understanding of the importance of leaving a strong legacy of faith and faithfulness to the younger generations as they seek to deepen their relationship with the Lord.

How does this Ministry support the overall mission of FBC Cochran? Legacy Builders provide a solid foundation for our church. They have a strong witness to God’s work in their lives through the years. They are dedicated prayer warriors who believe in praying for the lost. Their life experiences can provide wisdom for our church leadership. They are also valuable mentors to the younger generations as they seek to deepen their relationship with the Lord.

What ministry accomplishments may be unknown to our church? The goal of Legacy Builders is to maintain a balance of fun and fellowship with ministry and missions. They do this through careful and prayerful planning of activities. They love to meet together for fellowship luncheons every other month. They also enjoy trips to interesting places and love to find really good places to eat. The ministry and missions portion of their program include reaching out to local organizations such as the Bleckley County School System, church sponsored FCA event, our local assisted living facilities and nursing home. They actively seek to find ways to meet the needs they might have. They also support the ministry of Sacred Roots Farm, W.I.N.G.S, and the Baptist Children’s Home in Baxley. They have two Bible Studies each year, using guest leaders as well as our own Legacy Builder members.

What is something people may not know about this Ministry? Legacy Builders are always looking for new members to join them! They sponsor intergenerational activities to include younger adults. They also partner with the youth of our church through the Elijah Prayer Partners. Legacy Builders are assigned a high school student that they can form a friendship with and pray with throughout the school year. Several of our Legacy Builder men provide daily security for our Little Light Preschool. They enjoy partnering with the FBC Threadbearers and their ministry opportunities.

How can the congregation pray for this ministry? Pray that our Legacy Builder Ministry can reach out to those who are not involved. Pray that they can encourage the younger adults (55-60) to join in ministry. Also pray for the health and safety of their members. Pray often for those who are homebound or in assisted living facilities or nursing homes.
