Update on BCLC

We are well into our tenth school year, and we are pleased to share this BCLC update. Since our last newsletter, here are some of the highlights of a very busy year.

- Combined Fall and Spring semester 388 students attended Bible Classes (Spring 90 new middle school students; Fall semester 298 elementary, middle & high school)
- > Students and advisors attended a Spring Field Trip where the movie "I Can" was shown and a Fall Field Trip where "The Best Christmas Pageant Ever" was shown.
- > Our ninth annual BCLC Dale Jones Memorial Scholarship was awarded.
- ➤ BCLC hosted a Prayer Walk for Our Schools with over 600 attending.
- ➤ 2025 -2026 New School Year 298 Students enrolled in Fall BCLC Classes
- Fall Classes for 2024 6 Middle School classes: 2 8th grade, 2 7th grade & 2 6th grade, 1 High School class and 11 classes of 5th grade students.
- ▶ BCLC students were involved with Operation Christmas Child
- > BCLC hosted a Thanksgiving Community Hymn Sing "Fanny Crosby Night"



BCLC Hosts Thanksgiving Community Hymn Sing


