

my last event will be overseeing the BCHS/FCA event which this year is a 3-day affair starting on **Tuesday, June 16, and finishing on Thursday, June 18**. We'll be hosting 4 high school teams bringing approximately 400 players and coaches to our campus. Between now and then, we have some tasks to complete by way of getting ready.

The worship event on our campus begins @ **7:30 on Wednesday evening (June 17)** out in the grass behind the Whipple House. Now here's the especially exciting part: early on **Thursday morning (June 18)** four groups of 3/4 men will be delivering biscuits and drinks to the teams where they are being housed and will have opportunity to talk with the players from that team that made decisions for Jesus the night before!

We need folks willing to loan generators, tailgate tents, heavy duty extension cords, or barn fans. Please call the church office if you are willing and able to loan equipment.

We need a baking brigade to make scrumptious cookies for the players and coaches. Jan Evans is leading this part of the ministry effort. If you are willing and able to bake some cookies and bag them 3 cookies to a bag, call Jan and let her know.

At 8:00 the morning of the FCA event (**Wednesday, June 17**), we need servants to help set up the 400 chairs, get the generators, fans, extension cords, and hospitality tents in place and ready to go. The more hands we have helping, the sooner we can get done!

All volunteers willing to help service during the event will need to **meet in the foyer at 6:00 pm** prior to the worship service in order to get all the food and bottled water in place as well as to make assignments for water duty, trash duty, traffic control, etc. We will have pizza available for all of our volunteers.

**Remember** to wear your green "SERVE." t-shirt to the event on Wednesday evening. If you did not get a "SERVE." t-shirt last year or if your dog ate it, we have some available for you. If you're able to help set up on Tuesday morning, you can go ahead and secure your t-shirt that morning. Everyone else can get theirs when we gather at 6:00 for instruction and prayer.

Now the most important part of our preparation! Following are some specific requests we need to be praying about:

- Pray for Matthew White and the other musicians that will be leading worship this year, and for Conner Evans who will be sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ.
- Pray for lost people to get saved and saved people to get serious about their walk with Jesus.
- Pray for an abundant turn-out of volunteers to serve during this event.
- Pray for God's will in all the details ( **including weather - no rain & lower heat!** ), pray for the binding of satan's schemes to disrupt the event, and pray for God's glory to drench the entire football camp & worship service.
