Clyde is currently in ICU @ Memorial Hospital in Savannah; I want to share the two latest texts I have received from Jan (as of the writing of this article on Tuesday morning).

 Jan: We all rested really well. We're heading that way now. The night nurse called us around 9:00 last night and gave a good update. All of his numbers seem to be improving. But there are so many issues. He is very restful. They seem to have a timeline for weaning him off the ventilator. It will still be a few days. There are low blood pressure issues, too. Dialysis must make BP drop because they are working hard to keep it up. I'll write more shortly.
