**Bloomfield Baptist Church Family,**

*“Jesus said to them, ‘Truly, I say to you, the tax collectors and the prostitutes go into the kingdom of God **before** you.’” (Matthew 21:31)*

In Matthew 21:28-46, Jesus shares two parables that point out the hypocrisy and hard heartedness of the religious leaders of His day.....as well as the need for everyone to repent and believe while there is still time to do so.

In verse 31, Jesus tells the chief priests and elders that the tax collectors and prostitutes who have repented are the ones who are going into the kingdom.....but notice Jesus says “before you” not “instead of you”.

I do not think Jesus is promising salvation to the unrepentant in this verse.....I think He is stilling giving them an opportunity to repent and believe.

Is there someone in your life who has yet to repent and have faith in Jesus Christ? There is still time. They are not so far gone that God cannot reach them.

Pray for the Holy Spirit to burden them with the weight of their sin (Romans 3:23 & 6:23). Share with them about the goods news of Jesus Christ (Romans 5:8). Call on them to repent and believe in the gospel of our Lord Jesus (Romans 10:9-10).

God is doing great things in our community and in the world through the advance of His Kingdom.....and I believe that greater things are still to come!
