- Keeping all food service environments clean and orderly. These areas include, but are not limited to the kitchen, dining room, stock room, refrigerators, walk-in cooler, and other areas food may be served.
- Clean-up following each meal.
- Oversight of any kitchen help.
- Taking inventory and assisting in the preparation of the weekly order of food and supplies.
- Unloading and putting away the food delivery.
- Keeping records of number of meals served.
- Smile and interact with the campers as opportunity and time allows..

## **Qualifications:**

- 18 years of age or older.
- Ability to function well in a high-activity, often noisy environment.
- Previous experience in cooking for groups is advantageous.
- A love for children and a desire to use the camp environment to draw children into a new or deeper relationship with Jesus Christ.
