

Clerk's Corner:

The following information was reported at the May 26, 2020, Session meeting, which was held electronically with Zoom technology:

- **Correspondence:** Letter of appreciation from SERRV thanking us for our gift in March; letter from the Rev. Dr. Tricia Tedrow, stated clerk of Mission Presbytery informing the session that the minutes for 2019 have been reviewed and approved without exception.
- **Deaths:** none (hallelujah!)
- **Move to Inactive Roll:** Pat and Tom Stoner have moved to a retirement facility in Abilene, TX.
- **Communion:** Communion was celebrated at the live-streamed 11:00 am worship service on May 03, 2020. There was no extended communion served due to the COVID-19 crisis.
- **Re-Opening Task Force:** The members of the task force are in agreement that we should not resume in-person worship any time soon. Feedback requested from the congregation indicated that all who replied were in favor of this decision and were appreciative. The first phase of re-opening other parts of the campus will allow small groups of church members (10 or fewer), who will follow strict guidelines of social distancing, wearing face masks, and sanitizing surfaces after each use. The staff will return to regular hours beginning June 1.
- **Financial Report:** The April financial statements were reviewed. Overall, year-to-date income continues to exceed expense. PPP (Payroll Protection Program) made it possible for Children's Corner to stay in business. Appreciation was expressed for all the hard work and hours given by Treasurer Charles Sullivan.
- **Deacons:** The deacons are continuing to check on their flocks and co-ordinate care with the Rev. Susan Montoya, Director of Congregational Care.
- **Personnel:** Reported that the Interim Pastor contract has been signed and filed with the Commission on Ministry of Mission Presbytery. Announcement of name soon.
- **Worship and Stewardship:** Reported that pulpit supply for June is as follows:

 - June 14-The Rev. Susan Montoya, Director of Congregational Care-FPC-Kerrville
 - June 21-The Rev. Gini Norris-Lane, executive director of UKirk Ministries, PCUSA

- **Pastor's report:** David Evans submitted a written report and expressed his appreciation for his time with us.

The following items were acted upon and approved:

- Approved the recommendation of **Budget & Finance** to authorize and instruct the church treasurer to prepay the Small Business Administration loan granted to the church under the Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) in an amount equal to any loan proceeds remaining in the PPP loan account at Community First National Bank after payment of all amounts for forgiveness under the PPP.
- Approved the recommendation of **Planning & Training** to approve the proposed changes to the Standards of Procedure (SOP)—Appendix C-Christian Funeral Policies and Guidelines.
- Approved the recommendation of **Property** for the use of FLC **if the way be clear** by St. Peter's Episcopal Church for their denomination's youth Happening Aug. 7-8, 2020.
- Approved the recommendation of **Worship & Stewardship** that the local portion (40%) of the Pentecost offering be designated to the Hill Country Youth Ranch.
- Approved the recommendation of **Worship & Stewardship** to commit to long-term production of live-streaming worship services and consideration of resulting hardware, software, training, and license costs.
- Elected Zoe Van Dyke, Blake Smith, Jean Weber, Max Reinhardt, and Judy Ferguson to serve as commissioners to the stated meeting of Mission Presbytery via Zoom June 05-06, 2020.
