**Read John 4:43-54**

**Key Word- "Signs."** The people around Jesus at the time only believed because of the miraculous signs. But one man was different. The official asked for Jesus to come back with him to heal his son. Jesus simply told the man that his son was healed. The man could have debated and refused to believe unless Jesus came with him. Instead, he believed the simple promise of Jesus that his son was recovering. In fact, he seemed to not be in a huge rush to get home because he didn't meet his servants on the way until the next day (the journey could have easily been made in one day). He rested in Jesus's promise.

### **Key truths from this passage:**

- God requires faith of his people even when circumstances seem to indicate that we should not have faith

- Guard against superficial faith that is fueled only by seeing "signs."
