Dear 2025-2026 Upward Participant,

Thank you for registering your child for our 2025-2026 Upward Season. This packet is to inform you of the important dates and information that you will need to know throughout this basketball and cheerleading season.

Here are some things we want you to know!

- All communication will be through email and or text this season. There will be no physical letters sent out unless, you specifically specify that you would like it sent to your home address.
- We operate during the weekdays on the Alton School District Weather Policy. If classes are canceled or let out early that day, practices are canceled that evening. If we have a late afternoon weather event that doesn't impact the school but may impact practice, we will send out an email/text and a notice will be posted on our website at www.calvarycares4u.org, and on our Facebook Page "Upward Sports Calvary Baptist Church Alton IL". You may also call the church office at 618-462-8816 from 7:00 a.m.- 4:30 p.m. Monday-Thursday and on Friday from 8:00 a.m.- Noon.)
- WE HAVE A FACEBOOK PAGE!!! Be sure to Like/Follow us on Facebook "Upward Sports Calvary Baptist Church Alton IL". We will post cancelations, updates, pictures, videos, and any other important information on our page.
- Evaluation day is listed on the attached schedule. This is an important day, allowing your child to be placed properly in the league. There will only be 1 evaluation day. It will be on Saturday, November 8. Every child that is participating MUST BE evaluated. Please note that you may bring your child in any time during that day. Each child's evaluation should only last about 30 minutes, and then they are free to leave. EVERY CHILD MUST HAVE AN ADULT IN THE GYM DURING EVALUATION. CHILDREN WILL NOT BE EVALUATED IF AN ADULT IS NOT PRESENT.
- Evaluation day will mark the close of registration. The league will be drafted based on the number of registrants. Team leadership will be assigned and practices will start the second week of January.

Game Day

- Upward Basketball and Cheerleading is a ministry of the church and as such, it is our goal to share the love of Christ with your children and plant principles in their lives that help to build character and their spiritual life.
- Halftime of the games will introduce a high energy 5–7 minute interactive segment that teaches a life principle from Scripture. Practices will involve doing the same with children during their weekly practice session. Please be considerate to the person that is speaking as they have worked hard to prepare what they will be sharing with you.
- One thing you may not be aware of is once you enroll your child in the Upward Basketball Program, you will have prayer support. We will have many of our people praying for each child and their family throughout the Upward season.

There is a genuine sense of excitement about the year ahead of us. We want to make it a high quality, positive, meaningful, and encouraging experience for each child and their family. In an attempt to better stay in touch with you, here is the schedule of communication over the next months.

Mid December

All registrants will receive an **email** (unless specified that you would rather have a physical letter sent to your home) noting their team information, practice schedule day/time, game schedule.

January 19-January 24

Information and Picture Day Registration Forms about the upcoming January 31 Picture Day will be available at the practices.

January 26-January 30

You will receive an **email** (unless specified that you would rather have a physical letter sent to your home) with information about Upward Picture Day on January 31.

Dear Upward Parents,

Game days are always full of fun and excitement. At Calvary, we always strive to make sure that our Upward game days are fun-filled and family friendly.

In order to maintain a good atmosphere and promote great sportsmanship, we will be implementing a few specific rules. If a **player** becomes too aggressive during a game, the referee will give them a verbal warning. If it happens a second time, the player will be benched for the remainder of the period. If it is within the last minute of the period, the player will sit out the following period. If it is within the last minute of the game, the player will sit out the first period of the following game.

If a **player** uses foul language that a referee, coach, or staff hears, that player will automatically be benched for the remainder of the period. If it is within the last minute of the period, the player will sit out the following period. If it is within the last minute of the last of the game, the player will sit out the first period of the following game. If a player uses foul language during practice and the coach hears it, the player will sit out the first period of the following game day.

If a **spectator** uses foul language that a referee, coach, or staff hears, they will automatically be asked to leave the building on the <u>first offense</u>. This is a church and a Christian church ministry and we want to maintain that kind of atmosphere throughout our facility.

Please remember that **ALL** coaches and referees are parent/church member volunteers. They are giving their time to come and be a part of your child's game.

We thank you for registering your children for our 2024-2025 Upward season. We pray that it will be our best season to date!

IMPORTANT NOTE Your Child's safety is important to us. We ask that you come inside to pick them up after practices. We will not allow children to exit without an adult. If there are special circumstances, please contact us.
