We are happy to announce our 15th Annual Holiday Craft Sale. BIGGER AND BETTER THAN EVER! We are expanding to a 2-day event this year. Come enjoy two days of selling and meeting and greeting new and old friends. (limited 1-day booths are also available).

ALL BOOTH PROCEEDS GO TO SUPPORT MISSIONARIES AROUND THE WORLD!!!!!!

In the spirit of the Craft Sale, we ask that all your products are handcrafted, not factory produced. We're sorry, but booths for home party business and direct sales will not be accepted for the Holiday Sale.

After receipt of your application you will receive an email or phone call confirmation notifying you that your payment has been received and accepted. If for some reason we cannot accommodate your reservation, you will receive a full refund along with email communication or a phone call.

Registration Fees: (Your fee is a donation to Missions!)

\$70.00 – 2 -day booth. The space is 8 ft wide x 10 ft deep. Two chairs will be furnished per booth. We ask you to respect the boundaries taped out for your space. An additional fee will be charged if boundaries are exceeded.

\$35.00 – for a 1-day booth. 1-day spaces are limited on a first come first serve basis.

\$5.00 – 8 ft table....1 table per booth. Tables are limited so they will be on a first come first serve basis. (We have a total of 20 tables to rent.)

\$5.00 – Electricity. You will need to supply your own extension cords.

Set-up Schedule:

Friday, November 8, set up will be from 8-10 a.m. doors open at 11:00 a.m.

Saturday, November 9 set up will be from 7-8:30 a.m., doors open at 9:00 a.m.

There will be free coffee for all vendors both days for 1 hour prior to show times.

Lunch Counter:

A lunch counter will be available all day both days until supplies are gone. Included in your registration packet will be a copy of the menu and a \$1.00 off coupon toward your lunch both days. You won't even have to leave your booth. We will even pick up your lunch order and deliver it to you.

Application Procedure:

Vendor Responsibilities:

- A. Upon approval of your application, no refund will be made for cancellation by the vendor.
