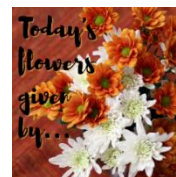

Naming Our Church



Church Naming Process began with getting name suggestions from the congregation that included a rationale for the name. After reception, each name was reviewed separately and prayed over. There were 48 names in total. First, we removed the names that were already used by Lutheran churches in the area. Next, we removed the names that were used by other churches in the area. Then we selected a name that represented variations of a common theme (ex. "Pilgrims of the King" and "Christ Pilgrim" = "Pilgrims of Christ"). This scrub left 11 names. The sub-committee then considered the rationale of each of the remaining names and selected 4 to present to the congregation to vote upon.
