Call to Worship Psalm 40:1-11

Leader: I put all my hope in the Lord. He leaned down to me; he listened to my cry for help.
All: He lifted me out of the pit of death, out of the mud and filth, and set my feet on solid rock.

Leader: He steadied my legs. He put a new song in my mouth, a song of praise for our God.
All: Many people will learn of this and be amazed; they will trust the Lord.


