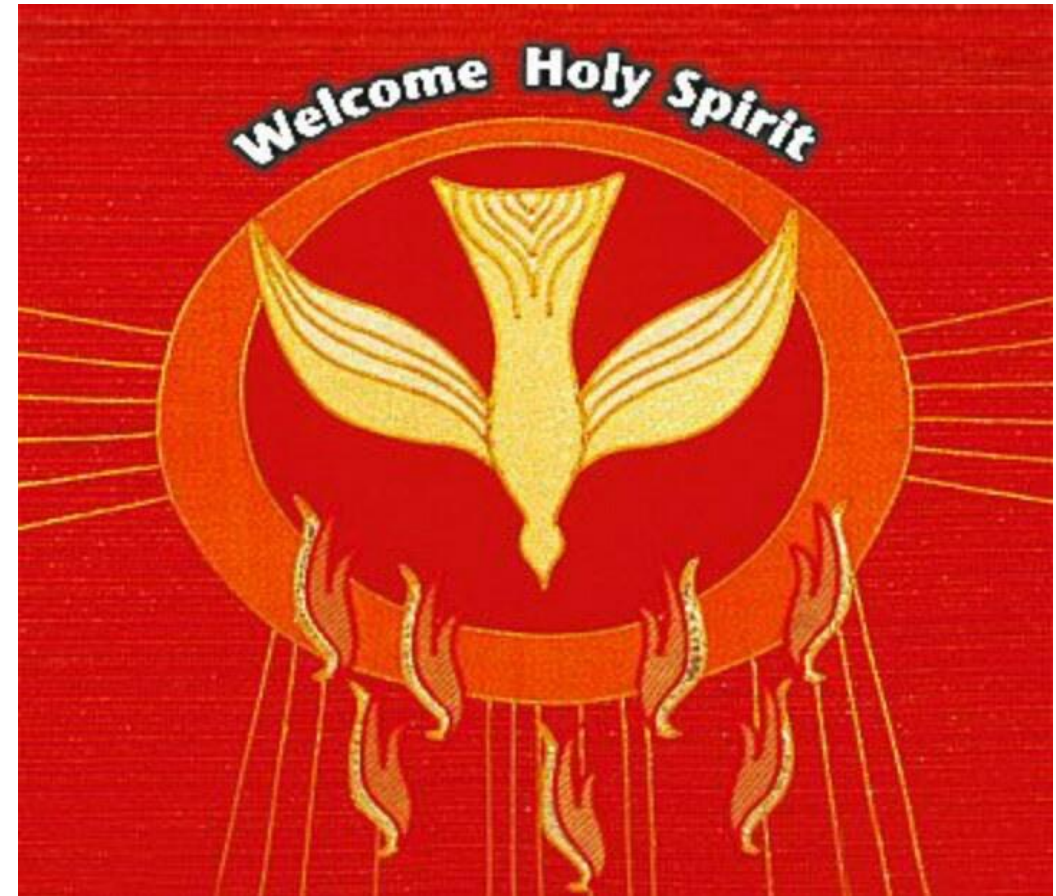
The Altar flower chart is up in the Social Hall. Sign up for a Sunday!
