

Ministry Phase Plans

Cleaning and Sanitization by the Facilities Ministry

- The facility ministry is regularly participating in Covid-19 sanitization training.
- Serv Pro will conduct germicidal fogging within the building upon completion of training and as needed in case of exposure incidents.
- Will sanitize prior to each service and between services.
- They will also do periodic bathroom fresheners throughout service.

Basic Service Details

- Our goal is to shorten the service time to 70-minute services.
- There will be a designated entrance at the front of the building (regular entrance).
- We will exit through the sanctuary doors.
- There will be sanitization stations in the foyer that will have hand sanitizers and masks available.
- Signs for Masks & Social Distancing along with other reminders will be posted.
- Congregation will pre-register for service and will be seated by a Host (ushers & greeters).
- There will be social distance stickers available to indicate comfort/lack of comfort (eg. "I am okay with an air hug." or "We can greet by touching elbows.").
- Pastor Dan will preach from stage.
- We will Live Stream the 1st Service.

Kidzville 1st Phase Reopening Plan

- Due to social distancing and the need for disinfecting all surfaces, we will not have Sunday School, Nursery, or Children's Church ministries during the service.
- Nursery will be temporarily used for nursing mothers, and we will have baby changing stations available (6 feet apart) with proper cleaning supplies available for use.
- We will continue posting our lessons online
- We will have lesson materials available in the lobby ready for pick up with a set of crayons that you will take with you and bring back to church every Sunday.
- Headphones will be available for purchase to listen to lesson videos during service (\$1.00 per headphones).
- Snack and small water will be individually packaged in a Ziplock bag attached to clipboard.
- After service, parents will need to drop their clipboard into a bin to be sanitized.
- Team members will be trained on new procedures before the Phase 2 opening of Kidzville.

R3 Student Ministry

- Currently meeting (primarily outside).
- They will be following all social distancing and mask requirements.
- They are serving prepackaged individual snacks only.
- They will reevaluate the plan for August and Phase 2 based on CDC recommendations.

Celebrate Recovery (CR)

- CR will resume their regular ministry meetings on Tuesday, August 4, 2020 with the CDC guidelines in place.
- No childcare provided.
- CR is suspending food and drinks. Therefore, they will eliminate the 6pm to 7pm fellowship time and start the large group meeting at 7:00 pm.
- CR requires everyone to wear a mask at all times and remain 6 feet apart.
- CR will dismiss the participants immediately after small group sharing ends.
- The CR staff will sanitize the areas that we use before we exit the building.

Planted Discipleship Ministry

- Phase One (July-September)
- There will be a call to salvation after Sunday's message.
- Those accepting Christ or re-dedicating will text first and last name to 888.600.4016.
- Discipleship team member will make contact within the hour after service.
- Team member will gather contact information, send salvation packet content through email and schedule Zoom Discipleship Meetings.
- No online or in-person discipleship classes.

Altar Ministry

- They will offer Zoom gatherings after each service.
- Prayer Requests Cards will be online.

Administration

- Bulletins & Service Notes will be digital for download.
- Connection Cards will also be online.

Ushers

- Offering will be online/text to give. There will also be a collection box stationed on the wall as you exit the building.
- Ushers and Greeters will seat those with a reservation one group at a time.
- There will be preassigned seats based on your reservation.
- Anyone who comes without a reservation, and parents with children who are not able to remain in the sanctuary, will be in the overflow area.

FIT

- They will help to seat people with reservations.
- They will answer questions as needed.
- They will help to distribute PPE & comfort stickers.
- They will be responsible for reservations and seating charts.

Worship, Sound & Media

- Smaller Team to start.
- They will sanitize all equipment before and after every use.

- We will continue to broadcast online services.
- Social media will continue to communicate about RCC Events and weekly activities.
