MLCA Service Hour Requirements

As part of Moses Lake Christian Academy policy, all secondary students must complete community service hours each year. Middle school students are required to complete ten (10) total service hours while high school students are required to complete twenty (20) total service hours for the 2024-2025 school year. As the bible calls us to a ministry of love in serving others, we seek to be leaders in service by serving our neighbors. We serve by actively getting involved in the meeting of the needs of those around us, in our church, and in our neighborhood.

In alignment with this call to action and the MLCA core value of servant leadership, middle school students will be required to complete a minimum of five (5) service hours per semester for a total of ten (10) and high school students will be required to complete a minimum of ten (10) service hours per semester for a total of twenty (20). **Service areas/activities must be approved before completion**.

Definition of Service Hours: The giving of one's time, treasure, and/or talents outside of school for the purpose of benefiting the community (local or global) or those in need, without compensation (monetary or otherwise).

Examples of Acceptable Service Hours:

- Church/Faith Based Helping widows, orphans, and shut-ins, serving at church, working with Youth Dynamics, outreach projects, etc.
- Non-profit Animal shelter, Habitat for Humanity, Meals on Wheels, Boys and Girls Club, etc.
- Community Adopt-A-Highway, Community Clean-Up, humanitarian projects, etc.

Guidelines for Verification Forms:

- A supervisor from the ministry/organization must be able to verify the hours completed with a signature and current contact information. If the service cannot be verified the hours will not be counted.
- Parent/guardians and/or students may not sign as a supervisor on the verification form.
- Please print neatly and have all sections and signatures completed to receive credit for your service.
- The verification form needs to be completed by the student and turned into the office within two weeks of completing the service hours.
- All service work and completed verification forms must be turned in prior to the final week of the semester.

All questions/approval of projects are to be directed to the student's bible teacher.
