Easter - Alive with Christ

1 Corinthians 15:1-11, 20-22

Main Point: The historical resurrection of Jesus is the foundation for Christian faith.

Summary: When Paul was in Corinth, he preached the gospel, the good news. Paul did not dream up this story; he heard it and believed it, and he turned around with what he had received and told anyone who would listen about who Jesus is and what He has done. Paul wanted us to understand the link between Jesus' resurrection and our hope. Because Jesus lives, we know that we too will live. Because Jesus has defeated death, we know that death doesn't have the final word over us.

Questions:

1. What aspect of the gospel is the hardest to believe?
2. How much does the resurrection of Jesus Christ impact how you live? In what ways has how you live been changed?
3. How can we, as a family, be more mindful of people around us who may not be Christians?
4. How does this Easter story give us hope and encouragement in our lives?
