



Frequently Asked Questions

Can I change my child's camp selections after I register?

Yes, we would be glad to change your child's camp selections for you, as long as you do so by **June 15, 2026**. Camp selections cannot be changed after **June 15, 2026** or during the week of camp.

Can I request that my child be in camps with their friends?

You may make this request; however, camps are on a first come, first serve basis. Additionally, some camps are divided by age, so there may be other factors preventing your child and their friends from being in the same camp. We will try to accommodate the best we can, but we can make no promises.

When will my child receive their camp schedule?

Camp schedules are handed out on Monday morning when you check in.

What if I need to cancel my child's registration?

We understand that circumstances may arise where you would need to cancel your child's registration. If you cancel by **June 1, 2026**, you will be refunded whatever amount you have paid toward your child's camp. If you cancel after **June 1, 2026**, you can be refunded up to 50% of your final balance. If you cancel after camp has started on **July 6, 2026**, you will be required to pay the entire camp cost. Please remember that all registrations are final after **June 15, 2026**. See our Parent Packet for more information about payment and our cancellation policy.

What time can I drop off my kids each day? Is there an early drop off?

Drop off begins at **7:45AM** each morning. Please enter the main doors near the big cross in the parking lot. We do not offer early drop off before **7:45AM**.

What if I need to drop my child off late one day?

If you need to drop your child off after camp has already started (after **8:30AM**), then you must go through the church office. Please use the main doors off of University Street, under the steeple. Our office staff can let you in and contact the camp staff to come get your child and take them to their camp.

What if I need to pick my child up early one day?

If you need to pick your child up early (before **4:30PM**), then you must go through the church office. Please use the main doors off of University Street, under the steeple. Our office staff can let you in and contact the camp staff to bring your child to you.

Can I bring a lunch to my child during their lunch time?

No, we ask that you send a lunch with your child each morning (with your child's name written on it) and place them in the designated spot in the lobby upon arrival each day. Remember that we do not have the capability to warm up lunches, so please send a prepared lunch. We also ask that you do not bring lunches from local restaurants for your children.

Will my child receive a snack, or do I need to send a snack as well?

We provide snack for all campers in the mornings and in the afternoons. You do not need to send a snack with your child. If you have concerns about any food allergies your child might have, please contact Matt Brewer (mbrewer@fbcmartin.org) so that we can make accommodations.

What if my child loses something at camp? Is there a Lost and Found?

Yes, we have a lost and found at camp. Feel free to contact Matt or Katie Brewer, or any of our camp staff, when you drop off your kids to check our lost and found for any missing items. We will also ask kids about items that have been found during our worship times each day.

Do I have to use the car line, or can I just walk in to pick up my child?

You must use the car line each day when you pick up your child. We use a numbered system similar to our local schools in order to get all children dismissed from camp as quickly as possible. When parents pick their children up at the door, it slows down the car line. We will work hard to get your children to you as soon as we can and are constantly working to make our car line run more efficiently.

How does Parent Day work, and when can I come?

All parents, grandparents, and family members are invited to join us for Parent Day activities on **Friday, July 10**. Please enter the main doors near the big cross in the parking lot. Parent Day activities for the morning camps will take place from **9:00** until **10:15**, and Parent Day activities for the afternoon camps will take place from **2:00** until **3:15**. During that time, you will be able to experience a small portion of each camp your child has been attending. We understand if you are not able to make it to both the morning and afternoon Parent Day activities. Please feel free to come whenever you are able during those time frames.
