The Punishment and the Gift

Romans 6:23 and Genesis 3:14-24

Summary: The punishment for sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ. The punishment for sin is high, but it makes the gift of salvation even more amazing. God in His infinite love for us has provided a way for salvation even in the midst of our hopelessness, darkness, and despair.

Questions:

1. Adam and Eve were clothed by God before they were separate from God. This required an animal sacrifice. Why do you think God clothed Adam and Eve before He left? What does this tell us about God? (That He loves us)
2. Why is it so easy to become "used" to hearing the gospel and tune it out when we hear it talked about? How can you combat that?
3. Do you think the punishment for sin is fair? Why or why not?
4. If you were God in Genesis 3, how would you have handled it? Explain.
