6. Many people carry a mental picture of God shaped by past experiences or relationships. How do you picture God and what has influenced that? Share your thoughts.
7. If God is both powerful Creator and personal Father, what is one step you can take this week to move toward knowing Him more personally through prayer, honesty, Scripture, or trust? Share your thoughts.
8. Who in your life might need to know and understand this Truth today? What is your best next step to show up for them this week? Share with the group so we can pray with you about it.
