## Discussion Guide

1. What is one thing from the message that stood out, challenged, or stretched you this week?
2. What is the first thing you remember doing that would qualify as sin? Were you caught in it or just realized it? What happened and how did you feel? Share your story.
3. Why do you think we have a tendency to rank sin? Does it change the outcome of the sin or the way that God views it? Why or why not? Share your thoughts.
4. Take a moment to think about 5-6 sins and rank them how you think most people would rank them (1 being the worst and 6 being not bad). Are there any of these that people might label as unredeemable? Do you agree? Why or why not? Share your thoughts.
5. Read Romans 3:23 together. Explain what you see in this verse. How does it make you feel? Share your thoughts.
6. Read Romans 8:1 together. Explain what you see in this verse. How does it make you feel? Share your thoughts.
7. We realized that we are all guilty but Jesus offers to redeem us. Who is in your life that needs to understand that Jesus is ready to redeem them? What is your best next step to love them into life change and share the hope of the Gospel with them this week? Share with the group so we can pray for you.
8. Take a few minutes to SOAP through one of the passages referenced in the message today. These are found on the top of the notes page. You may want to include verses before/after the passage listed too. Share your insights with the group.
