7. If someone asked you, “What or Who is the Holy Spirit?”, how would you answer today? How would you explain the Spirit in a way that is truthful, clear, and loving — not argumentative? Share your thoughts.
8. Who in your life might need to know and understand this Truth today? What is your best next step to show up for them this week? Share with the group so we can pray with you about it.
