- 2. Have you ever experienced some kind of persecution because of your faith? What was the situation and how did you handle it? Share your story.
- 3. Read Matthew 10:16. Who or what do you think are the "wolves" that He is sending us into? Why do you think Jesus is sending His followers to the wolves? What do you think it looks like, in practical terms, to be "wise as serpents and innocent as doves"? Share your thoughts.
- 4. Jesus says that opposition can come from many places including family, friends, coworkers, etc. How do you maintain those relationships and influence while staying true to the obligations of your faith?
