5. What notes from today so you most need to cling to right now? Do any of these change the way you approach the Bible and your view of it being God's Word? Share your thoughts.
6. Today we said a Bible you don't apply is truth you're not standing on. What is one specific way you need to stop just hearing God's Word and start building your life on it? Is there an area where God's Word is calling you to obey, change direction, trust Him more, or live differently?
7. If someone asked you, "What is the Bible and is it trustworthy", how would you answer today? How would you explain the Spirit in a way that is truthful, clear, and loving — not argumentative? Share your thoughts.
8. Who in your life might need to know and understand this Truth today? What is your best next step to show up for them this week? Share with the group so we can pray with you about it.
9. Take a few minutes to SOAP through one of the passages referenced in the message today. These are found on the top of the notes page. You may want to include verses before/after the passage listed too. Share your insights with the group.
