1. What is one thing from the message that God used to encourage, challenge, or grow you?
2. Think about a relationship (friendship, dating, family, etc.) that has significantly shaped your life. In what ways did it influence your direction, decisions, or character?

4. Read Genesis 1:27–28. What stands out to you about being created in the image of God? How does this shape the way you view people, relationships, and the value of others?
5. Read Genesis 2:24. What do you notice about the design and purpose of the “one flesh” relationship? How is this different from how relationships are often approached in culture?
6. Read Matthew 19:4–6. Why do you think Jesus points back to creation when talking about relationships? What does that reveal about how we should understand love and marriage? Now read Ephesians 5:31–32. What stands out to you about marriage pointing to Christ and the church? How does that elevate the purpose of love beyond just personal happiness?
7. Every relationship is shaping you in some direction. What is one relationship or pattern in your life that is currently influencing you the most? Is it moving you toward Jesus or away from Him?
8. What is one step you can take this week to bring a relationship, desire, or pattern under the leadership of Jesus—whether that means setting a boundary, seeking wisdom, or taking a step of obedience?
9. Take a few minutes to SOAP through one of the passages referenced in the message today. These are found on the top of the notes page. You may want to include verses before/after the passage listed too. Share your insights with the group.
